“The LEADER’S EDGE” by drmichaelbell

This month’s spotlight is on consistency, one of the most underestimated forces in ministry. Picture a leaky faucet. No matter how tightly you turn the handle, it continues to drip, one drop at a time, steadily and persistently. Before long, the sound becomes irritating. Yet place that same drip in the right environment and give it enough time, and something remarkable happens. That slow, steady drip has the power to shape stone.



That’s how canyons are formed. Not through sudden force or dramatic moments, but through the power of consistency.

The same principle applies to discipleship and ministry. One of the ongoing challenges clergy and lay leaders face is the ordinary, sometimes repetitive nature of growth in Christ. There’re only so many creative ways to encourage people to read Scripture, pray, serve others, give generously, and remain engaged in ministry.

There’ll be many days when the people we lead, and even we ourselves, will not feel motivated. They may not feel like showing up to serve or continuing to give themselves to ministry. While following Christ can be deeply meaningful and inspiring at times, it’s often quiet, repetitive and demanding.

Over the long run, consistency proves more powerful than excitement. Effective leaders help others understand why.

1. Consistency emphasizes faith over experience. Consistency is a visible expression of trust. When someone continues faithful practices day after day, regardless of mood or motivation, it reveals a life guided by conviction rather than emotion. People read Scripture because they believe it shapes how they live. They pray because they trust God hears them, even when prayer feels dry.

Leaders encourage this kind of consistency by modeling it themselves and by teaching that faithfulness matters more than feelings. Consistency stabilizes people and anchors them during seasons of uncertainty.

2. Consistency causes roots to grow deep. When you opt for consistency over excitement, you’re

developing the kind of practices that will carry you through the seasons of drought and dryness all of us will encounter sooner or later, or more later than sooner. In other words, your roots are growing deep.

Clergy and lay leaders serve well when they encourage people to remain faithful even when nothing feels extraordinary prepares them for moments when their faith is tested. Roots grown in ordinary days provide strength for extraordinary challenges.

3. Consistency shapes the whole of life. One often overlooked benefit of consistency is its impact beyond church settings. Faithful habits influence how people manage time, relationships, responsibilities and stress. Over time, consistency produces emotional equilibrium, mental clarity and disciplined living.


Faith was never meant to be partitioned. Loving God involves every part of life. Leaders reinforce this truth by helping people see that consistency in ministering to others, showing up, serving faithfully and loving patiently, forms lives marked by integrity and wholeness. Consistency rarely feels impressive in the moment. It doesn’t generate applause or instant results. But over time, it shapes disciples, strengthens churches and leaves lasting impact on communities.

Speak Life Thought

“A Persistent Life”

“10 Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime. 11 Then these men assembled, and found Daniel praying and making supplication before his God.” (Daniel 6:10-11)

Daniel is a prophet who was chosen to serve in the king’s court. With that appointment came jealousy and envy from his haters. His life serves as an example of persistence despite resistance. The word “persistent” means to firmly press on despite difficulty or opposition.

Daniel was aware of the spiritual condition of the country he lived in. After he read Nebuchadnezzar’s decree about praying to no other god but the king, he went home to pray as he always did to the Almighty God. The decree did not shake his faith nor cause him to walk in fear. He was persistent in his faith in God and opened his window and began to pray as he always did.

Daniel did not allow his emotions to alter his prayer life.

He knew he was not liked. Everything he did was being scrutinized. He had to battle jealous spirits and deal with ignorant folks, but not once did it stop him from getting into the presence of God. He did not let his emotions get the best of him. In fact, he was bold in his profession when he opened the window and prayed not once but three times a day. We too should be just as bold to pray whenever there is an opportunity, inside and outside the Church walls.

He made a visible display of his commitment to persistently pray. This prayer posture speaks of the heart of Daniel, who prayed for a nation even when many were hostile towards him. Jesus Christ demonstrated this when he prayed for his persecutors (Luke 23:34). Ephesians 6:18 says, “Pray in the Spirit at all times and on every occasion. Stay alert and be persistent in your prayers for all believers everywhere.” As believers, we are to be suited and booted to pray persistently, no matter how the world around us is falling apart.

He was not ignorant of the fact that his prayers would stir up his enemies. Even after being accused and not denying it, and being thrown in the lion’s den, Daniel was persistent in his faith, “and no manner of hurt was



found upon him, because he believed in his God” (Daniel 6:23). Persistent faith in God pleases Him (Hebrews 11:6). When you pray, you will stir up strife in the spiritual realm that will agitate the kingdom of darkness. Do not back down. You are doing exactly what Jesus instructed you to do—pray and do not retreat (Luke 18:1)! Stand your ground.

So, dear hearts, be determined and persistent to remain firm in faith, pray often, and rejoice always.

HISTORY OF GREATER NEW HOPE MISSIONARY CHURCH

Celebrating 88 Years of Ministry



J. W. Brumfield was called. He served as pastor of the church for 2 years.

In March 1972, Reverend W. H. Miller was called to pastor GNHMBC. Rev. Miller was responsible for countless accomplishments.

The history of Greater New Hope Missionary Baptist Church (GNHMBC) spans a period of 87 years.

The church was organized in 1938 by the late Reverend W.T. Bolden in his home on Annie Street. Reverend Bolden received a phone call which led to the purchase of the property at 1515 Kennedy Street Ft. Worth TX. 76102. Rev. Bolden served as pastor of the church for about 3 years.

In 1941, the late Reverend Bernard Hurd was called. Although his tenure as pastor was brief GNHMBC continued to remain faithful to God.

In the fall of 1942, the late Reverend Dr. L. P. Mitchell was called. Rev. Mitchell encouraged an extensive building program which included the completion of a totally remodeled sanctuary and the construction of an educational building. Rev. Mitchell served as a devoted pastor and leader for 25 years, until his health failed him.

Interim Pastor, Reverend Henry Rayford, presided until Reverend

On October 25,1980 at 2:30am, the church building located at 1515 Kennedy Street was destroyed by fire. Reverend Dr. T. H. Davis and the Rising Star Baptist Church Family graciously extended an invitation for us to worship in their facilities. GNHMBC held worship services at Rising Star Baptist Church for 8 weeks. In January 1981, the present facility, located at 3920 East Rosedale Street was acquired. Rev. Miller worked with city officials to improve the area including the paving of East Rosedale Street. Many renovations and improvements were made, and blessings flowed abundantly. As a direct result of God's grace, acquisition of surrounding lots and the building was bricked.

In September 1996 the church note was paid off. In December 2000, Rev. Miller's Health failed him and he became Pastor Emeritus.

Reverend D. Bryan Ford served as Interim Pastor until January 2001 when he was called to pastor GNHMBC.

In November 2002 Reverend Ivy Haynes Jr. was called to pastor GNHMBC. Reverend Haynes was installed on April 13, 2003. Through the leadership and guidance of the Holy Spirit, Pastor Haynes has been a great inspiration in spiritual growth of the members at GNHMBC. Pastor Haynes served as pastor/teacher for 14 years until The Lord called him home on October 9,2016.



On June 25,2017 Reverend Reginald Andrews was called to pastor GNHMBC, he was installed August 27,2017. Pastor Andrews is a man after Gods own heart, thru his faithfulness and dedication of the members, God has blessed GNHMBC with spiritual growth and with a totally remodeled sanctuary, fellowship hall, men and women restroom, pastor study and all other offices in the church, church has been painted outside and new signs were added. All these renovations were done without borrowing any money. God is so good to GNHMBC and He is still blessing us.

God provided all the great blessings to us for which we are grateful under the leadership of 9 pastors over 88-year history in the life of Greater New Hope Missionary Baptist Church.




