"The LEADER'S EDGE" by dr. michael bell

Bill Hybels, Founding and Senior Pastor of Willow Creek Community Church, in Illinois, once said, "The Church is the hope of the world, and leaders are the hope of the church." Church leadership requires a different skill set than other leadership positions, which is why Church leadership training is so indispensable to the life and forward movement of any congregation. It is one thing to recognize the need for an effective leadership training strategy, it is quite another to implement the program. While everyone would admit that the need for leadership training in the Church is unquestionable, developing a practical, potent training blueprint remains one of the most difficult challenges any pastor faces.

I wish I had a dime for each time a frustrated pastor articulated the countless challenges facing the congregation he or she was leading. After asking me what I thought was needed and after I replied that the Church needed a leadership training schema, too many times the pastor responded that to set up a leadership training plan was just "too much work." So, his or her Church isn't able to move "out of stuck" because the pastor lacks the motivation to exert the necessary energy to engineer a leadership training process.

Let me be the first to admit that I really do understand the reluctance of a pastor to implement a leadership training game plan. Often ministry leaders have a view that they already are sufficiently trained to be effective for leadership. They see leadership training as a waste of valuable time when they could be doing something else. This often emanates from a misconception about leadership. And, when someone, particularly the pastor, brings up the need for leadership training, they literally resist the idea. This toxic attitude toward leadership training has to change IF the Church is to realize God's best!

To get us on the same page, let's delineate what is meant



by leadership training. Leadership training is the process of helping leaders at every level of leadership assess and cultivate their Christian character and acquire, reinforce, and refine their ministry knowledge and skills. Scripture provides principles to guide leadership training in all areas of ministry. In 2 Timothy 2:2, the Apostle Paul instructs leaders, "And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable men who will also be qualified to teach others."

If your Church is to get from here to there, the pastor and his leadership team must commit to create a culture of equipping and training. The following list will get you started. Leaders:

- must know God.
- need to know themselves, their strengths and weaknesses.
- need to know and understand people.
- need to know how to study the Bible and have a general knowledge of the Bible and theology.
- need to know how to pray.
- need to know and agree with the Church's mission statment, vision, strategy, core values, beliefs, doctrine, and direction.
- need to know how to thin and plan strategically.

We'll talk next month about what we were supposed to talk about this month - "How to Manage Minor Church Leadership Issues Before They Blow Up!"

"Speak Life Thought" with First Lady & Co-Pastor Yolanda G. Butler

"A Dull Life"

"Watch out! Don't let your hearts be dulled by carousing and drunkenness, and by the worries of this life. Don't let that day catch you unaware."

Luke 21:34 NLT

The word "dull" means to lack interest or excitement. Dull is something that you become and will affect what you do. Jesus warned to not allow our hearts to become dull because of the weight of life. The mandate on you as a person can be so pressing, causing you to become drained and outright exhausted. Let's be honest here for a moment. When you are mentally and physically tired, supporting your local church gets nudged down a few notches from the "Top Priority List." The way you are feeling right now, you could care less about the church, the church folk, the one-hour prayer meeting, the night time bible study, the three-day long revival, etc. I mean who wants to go straight to church after working nine hours and fighting two hours of traffic?! Your focus right now is that you want to go home, eat, fall to sleep in front of the T.V., and tend to your physical need to rest. Now don't get me wrong. Rest is important and we need it. It is in your physical rest that I want to encourage you

to also rest spiritually.

"Then Jesus said, 'come unto me

all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest." (Matt. 11:28) You become weary and exhausted when life's weights become so extreme, causing you to spiral downward. Praying, studying, fellowship with the saints is nowhere near on your agenda. It is at these breaking points that Jesus said to answer the summons to find rest in Him. Jesus shared that in this place called rest, you would do well to cease from any movement of labor in order to recover and collect strength. You rest in the natural, away from the noise, clutter, and clamor of life to quiet your mind and rest your body. While in this physical state of rest, you have the opportunity to also rest in the Lord through prayer, worship, and the meditation of God's Word. In other words, get in the presence of the Lord. This is a double win for you worth practicing. This two-step process of rest is vital to your need to recover and collect strength. Failure to do so will cause you to become weak and dull, making you vulnerable to the attacks of the enemy to wipe you out. Consequently, fighting against these wiles ("tricks") becomes difficult because your physical and spiritual reservoirs are empty from lack of replenishment.



When you become physically and spiritually dull you become slow-moving in the natural and spiritual things of life. You lack pep, drive, and passion for the very things that are meant to give you life—family, marriage, ministry, work, etc. Procrastination, excuses, and laziness, the byproducts of slow-moving, begin to manifest in your life. This can be dangerous ground for you now become prime prey for the attacks of the enemy. So my dear hearts, if you ever find yourself wandering into a dull state of life, enjoy the two-fold blessing of resting physically and spiritually, and begin this year by walking fresh in the abundant life through

Church Security in Light of Latest Shooting

The shooting at the Sikh Temple in Wisconsin will once again present the question of whether churches need their own security. It is a good debate to have as crimes against churches including shooting have increased tenfold in recent years. The issue is not if your church will be the victim of some sort of crime, but when.

Crimes against our nation's churches are grossly under reported for several reasons. We want to feel secure while we worship God, and that should be the case. However, there should be a quiet element at play during your services. One that goes unnoticed by the majority of church members.

Having a security ministry at your church need not be complex or financially expensive. Most churches have police officers or sheriff's deputies in their congregation. Whether retired or active, this is your security team. Most will volunteer their services to become a stabling influence in the safety of their church.

These church members are the only professionally trained to handle dire life threatening situations. Carry permit holders are just that permit holders. While some may consider them their unofficial security; it is improper and unfair to expect someone with 8 hours of training to respond properly to any type of criminal intruder. They are wonderful for self defense, but to require any more from them only opens your church and those members to criminal and civil liability.

In most cases your security program can be run with volunteers that commit themselves to a number of hours of monthly training.

The startup costs of this ministry should be minimal. Radio's, insurance, and licensing should amount to less than \$1000.00. You could well exceed that depending on how complex you want to make your system, but the things I mentioned are necessary for any program. A formal policy should be drafted by potential members of your team and the pastoral staff. This policy should draw out the protocol for responding to every imaginable situation. If constructed properly, this policy should protect the church and security program from liability.

You can choose to ignore the situation, but when your church is made out to be a victim, you will face possible litigation from a lack of adequate protection. Churches like any other business are responsible for the safety and security of its' staff and members. So is a security program needed? Yes. Is it warranted? Absolutely.

This is a simplistic look at church security. If you undertake a security program consult professionals such as myself in gathering the proper information to make an informed decision. This article was not written to make you rush into a security program, but to make you aware of the need.





From the Wilderness to Worship

Psalms 63:1-8

I. INTRODUCTION

There are many people in our bible that faced difficult days yet were determined to keep on working for the Lord. Although one may face unpleasant, unproductive, and uninhibited places in life, our God is able to see you through. These uncomfortable places in life are typical of a wilderness experience. Have you had any wilderness experiences in 2017? Did anyone experience the loss of a love one in 2017? According to Psalms 46:1, "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in the time of trouble." Someone may have lost a job in 2017 but the Lord can feed you in the midst of a famine. If we could talk to the prophet Elijah, he would tell us that the Lord can take care of His own. Our God can feed you by whatever means He deems necessary. Did the Lord bless you to pay your bills in 2017 when you didn't think that you

The bible shows us several examples of God's people in the wilderness. Abraham, Jacob, Moses, David, and Elijah experienced the wilderness. Their examples were meant to guide us as we pass through the wilderness experiences of this life (1 Cor. 10:11). Wilderness experiences are times of God's tests and trials in our lives. Have you been tested in 2017? The wilderness experience is a good place where God's people can learn faith and endurance.

Jesus faced the wilderness experience in Luke 4:1-13. The temptation of Jesus (Matt. 4:1-11) gives us some real guidelines for surviving our own wilderness experience. Initially, Satan tempted him in the area of provision. Jesus responded: "It is written: 'Man does not live on bread alone. but on every word that comes from the mouth of God."" (v.4). In the wilderness, there is neither natural bread nor any way of producing it. As a body of baptized believers, we have to learn that God is the source of everything.

The wilderness experience with all its tests and trials is summed up so well in the words of the song written back in the 70s by Andre Crouch:

Through it all, through it all, I've learned to trust in Jesus, I've learned to trust in God. Through it all, through it all, I've learned to depend upon his

As we approach our text, we will find that if we can trust the Lord and take Him at His Word then He will work it out. Let's see what the Lord tells us when we look at this scripture.

II. David's Thirst for God; v. 1-2

It is here we find David wandering as an exile. David is in exile because he is on the run from King Saul. King Saul sought to destroy his life. At this time, David is now separated from the courts of King



Saul and he is separated from the sanctuary. It is bad when sometimes church members cause other people to stumble. When we don't treat a member right, then they can jeopardize the member's relationship with the church and possibly the Lord. As mature Christians, we must seek to unify the body of Christ with the love of the Lord. David is looking for God in these couple of verses. When one is looking for the Lord, then one is in a barren and dry place. The wilderness of Judah is the placed that David is located in this text. The land has little or no rain, and it is too dry or barren to support vegetation. It was a dry place. This was a place with landforms narrower than a canyon. This place that David is in is similar to a canyon or a vallev with steep sides. There was no sweet sound of running water. It is only hot and barren terrain. It is a place where men and beast faint and die for want of water.

Man's appetite represents a desire for something. He or she knows that they are thirsty. Yet, mankind does not know what the thirst means. Sometimes man interprets the thirst for crack-cocaine. Sometimes man interprets the thirst as a need for vodka and gin or rum and coke. However, as Christians we know that whenever we can't feel God's presence, we are in a wilderness place. Nevertheless, our God can supply all of our needs according to His riches

When a man is drowsy, he has to sleep. Now allow me ask you a question. How many times have you been looking at television and went to sleep? Life for some people is like a mirage in the desert. Blessed are they who know where the fountain of living water resides. In the New Testament, Jesus told the woman at the well, "I can give you living water whereas you will never thirst again." It is this type of water that can clench man's thirst. My brother and my sisters do not mistake what it is that you need! Everyone should thirst after Jesus!

III. David's Satisfaction, v.3-7

It is here in these verses that the Psalmist has a sudden transformation. Despite all of the effects of the wilderness experience, David seeks the Lord. When we begin to seek the Lord in spite of our trials and tribulations, we will find real satisfaction. In the earlier verses, we saw a dry and barren land. However, in v. 7, we see the lush green vegetation. David is in a good place while he is in the wilderness of Judah. He begins to praise the Lord and this alone places him in a good place. When

praises go up, blessings come down.

and water in the wilderness. However, on the other hand, David's soul is satisfied with marrow and with fatness. The marrow and fatness is symbolic of an inward complacencv that one has when the Lord is in one's life. It represents a life that is filled with the pleasant things of life. When one has the Lord in their life, then one has everything they need. David is satisfied because he has remembered the Lord in spite of his wilderness experience. The soul that thirsts after God shall be satisfied. It takes man's indifference to the cross to keep God out of man's heart. In verse 3, David states "because thy loving-kindness is better than life, my lips shall praise thee." When David thought about the Lord's past blessings and past deliverances, he was encouraged. Sometimes we have to focus on what the Lord has already done for us. It was David that the Lord blessed to have victory over the lion and the bear. It was David that the Lord blessed to have victory over the giant. Since David had these victories, David encourages himself in the Lord. David begins to praise God in spite of the wilderness experience. Can you think about how the Lord has already blessed you? If so, you can be encouraged in your wilderness experience.

IV. David Moves Forward,

In verse 8, David tells us, "My soul follows hard after thee: thy right hand upholds me." This verse gives insight into David's earnest desire to keep up communion with God. If we cannot always have God in our embraces, we must always reach out to Him in praise. Per Phil. 3:14, we must reach forth towards Him as our prize. When we press hard after God, then we are following Him closely. As we reach toward God in all of our pursuits, we are sure to find him to be a refreshing place. As the Lord refreshes us for another day, we must acknowledge that it is to the glory of God. In all that we begin to say and do, our God must get the glory out of our lives. Is the Lord getting the glory out of your life? Has the Lord refreshed your spirit and you are ready to run on a little while longer? When we seek the Lord, we will find him. The Lord upholds the hand of the righteous. The Lord will give us the strength for the day. In 2018, we must continue to seek the Lord and know that He will uphold us in our wilderness experiences. To God be the glory!!!

"And if I perish, I perish," Said Esther. (Esther 4:16).

She was at a breaking point. Her people were suffering and facing sure destruction. Even though she had access to privilege, their suffering was her suffering. It got to the point where she felt like she had nothing



to lose and she was willing to risk her life to save her people.

Esther found herself in a position to make a difference. Not just for herself, but also for her people. God had given her favor, and she was willing to risk that He would do it again. And if He didn't, that would be okay too.

It was a calculated risk. She knew the potential cost. It could cost her her life. And she was willing to take that chance for the possibility of a good outcome. If she had done nothing, they would be doomed anyway.

Esther was about to do something that was not according to the law. She was stepping out of the box for a good cause; to save her people. The predicament catapulted her into a leadership position. Yes, the orphan girl became a leader. She respected and listened to her uncle Mordecai and she gleaned wisdom from him.

She knew she needed favor from God to pull this off. She knew she could not do it alone. So she called for a fast. She asked everyone to fast with her. After spending many years listening to her uncle Mordecai and following his instructions, the tables turned one day and then he listened to her and he did what she told him to. Ultimately, Esther's decisions and actions saved her people. She made a difference.

You never know what kind of situation you will find yourself in. Your choices and actions will make a difference. A situation in your life may be a lost cause and change is necessary. You may find yourself in a position to make the change. Think about those you've learned from. Think about how God's favor has worked in your life before and how He can do it again. Count up the costs. Think about the risks and what you stand to lose by stepping out of the box and doing something BIG.

Is it worth the risk to you? Are you willing to live with the possible consequences? At some point, when you're tired of being tired. Tired of being afraid. Tired of being stagnant. Tired of watching your loved ones suffer and struggle, and you realize you can make a difference. You just might get to the point where Esther was and say, "And if I perish, I perish." Sometimes it's just time for a change and that often requires us to put ourselves on the line. Pray about it. Let God lead you. Be strong and of good courage! (Joshua 1:6)
