


"The LEADER'S EDGE" by drmichaelbell

Leadership is about vision. One man says a leader is a person who knows the road, stays ahead, and pulls others with them. He was talking about vision. Another person offered this definition. A leader is one who sees more than others, farther than others, and before others. Again, he was talking about vision. So where does this vision come from? It comes from asking the right questions. Where do I want to go with my life? What do I want to accomplish? Those are the questions out of which vision is shaped. And a clear vision is the context out of which success usual-

Michael Johnson's name is known around the world. He is in fact one of the world's most famous athletes. At the 1996 Olympics Johnson achieved what no other runner ever accomplished up to that point. He captured two gold medals in the 200 meters and the 400 meters, and in the process, he shattered the previous world record set in the 200 meters. And he stumbled out of the blocks on his record setting race! So, we could say that Micheal Johnson is an achiever. He is a perfect example of the leadership tagline couched in Proverbs 29:18, "Where there is no vision, the people run wild."

But Michael Johnson learned an important lesson along the way from his father. Every time he burst into the house with some new dream of what he wanted to accomplish his father would always ask him this clearly unambiguous question: "How do you plan to do that?"

Futurist Joel A. Barker is credited with saying, "Vision without action is merely a dream. Action without vision just passes the time. Vision with action can change the world." That's what sets apart the dreamers from the achievers; they develop a plan to implement their dream. Anyone can have a dream. But to effectuate a plan that will enable us to achieve that dream—that is what makes the difference! ""Where there is no vision, the people run wild!" This catchphrase




isn't meant to discourage dreamers but simply to remind us that dreaming isn't the ultimate step but the penultimate step.

I saw an article that read, "Is Your Church's Future Rooted in Your Dreams or God's?" Isn't that a great question? It is applicable to your ministry, your choir and/or your committee. It's a probing interrogative and should be answered in the affirmative. Identify, embrace and actionize God's dream for your ministry!

Let me end our time together by encouraging you to continue to dream big dreams. And let's allow the visions to roll. But then we need to advantageously address the question: "How do I plan to accomplish that?" Visions are implemented by strategic planning. vision pictures a destination; strategic planning maps out how we will reach that destination. A vision that pictures a destination is important, but it is not the ultimate step in an effective life or ministry. The vision must be followed by strategic planning that maps out how we will reach that destination.

Speak Life Thought with First Lady & Co-Pastor Yolanda G. Butler

"A Covered Life"

7 But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer. 8 And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for **charity** shall **cover** the multitude of sins." (1 Peter 4:7-8)

We as believers of Christ are called to "be sober" or clear-minded. We are also called to "watch unto prayer" or have a prayerful attitude. Our motives and actions must be based on love. Why, "Because "charity" (love) covers a multitude of sins."

What exactly does "love covers a multitude of sins" mean? Does it mean that if a person sins, you just cover it up? Let's first define the word "love" in this passage to answer this question. The Greek word "love" is "agape," meaning spontaneous, self-giving unmerited love (John 3:16). Oxford Dictionary defines the word "cover" as to shield and protect from further exposure. The Greek meaning is to hide or veil the knowledge of a thing.

As Christians, we do not demonstrate LOVE by finding delight in exposing other's faults and sins. Rather, love seeks to prevent further exposure of the fault and reconcile a person to the cross.

When my children were faced

with marital breakdowns, I did NOT go around and call a bunch of folks including my family. I was not blind to what I was seeing nor did I condone or enable the actions of what led to the breakdown for I was and still am an active mother, grandmother, and mother in love.

Rather, I shielded (covered) the knowledge of the situation from outsiders and kept it before the Lord in prayer. Why? Because there was a lot on the line: 1) they were pastor's children, 2) their spouses were at one point highly active in ministry 3) they all had young children, 4) the hurt was deep and, 5) they didn't need a bunch of pity and gossip to flow from unrestrained lips. So, as a Mother, I "covered" my children. I shielded them from what was already a hurtful, broken, and even embarrassing situation because of the faults and sins of others that affected their entire family.

It would do me no good as a mother, a pastor's wife, or a child of God to call everyone in my cell or post it on social media; that's a wasted effort. Rather, I chose to "cover," shield them in prayer, and waited patiently for the Father to intervene in this most delicate situation. I chose to rise and be the supportive mother and intercessor they needed more than ever.

To this date, I have not shared all the pain or shame that my chil-



dren faced and will never discredit their ex-spouses because they are the parents of my grand-children. Why? Because love covers. It is the agape-love, the spontaneous, self-giving unmerited love. Agape-love covers, hides, and veils the knowledge of a matter publicly and privately war about it at the altar.

When you discredit a situation, and talk about it without any attempt of help, you are exposing it in the atmosphere for the enemy to run rampant with, causing havoc to an already devastating situation.

So dear hearts, be determined to shame the devil and reconcile others to the Father by covering them in love.

Legendary Fort Worth Dunbar boys basketball coach Robert Hughes has died at age 96

As the winningest coach in the history of high school basketball for boys, Robert Hughes made



his impact in the record books and in the hearts of everyone fortunate enough to work with or play for him.

From 1958-1973, Hughes was the

head coach of I.M. Terrell High School, an all-black school in Fort Worth, Texas where he refused to let society dictate the future of his players, often placing otherwise forgotten young men in junior colleges in the era of segregation in the South. When the school shut down in 1973, Hughes landed the job at Paul Laurence Dunbar High School where he would stay for 32 years. In all, the tough-minded and beloved coach won 1,333 games

with his fast-paced, full-court, high-flying brand of basketball. The show was above the rim, and Hughes pushed his most athletic players to the limit.

The 2003 National High School Coach of the Year led his teams to five state championships and 35 district titles, but the greatest pleasure for Hughes was seeing his players work hard to experience success on and off the court.

8 Reasons a Church Choir Is Important by Mark Cole



I recently started conducting a choir after many years of just doing worship teams. Here are 8 great reasons to consider adding a choir to your congregation.

It provides opportunities for many members to serve. Think practically for a minute: A Bible study program requires one to two facilitators per group, but a choir requires many people to serve. Open choir seats are opportunities to serve.

It helps produce good congregational singing. A praise team can achieve this goal, too, but it's easier to worship through song when dozens of people are leading the way.

A good choir sings and illustrates joy. It's not just the singing that makes a difference. It's also the smiling. It's the worshiping through

raising hands. It's the singer who closes his eyes and takes us to God through his own personal worship. It's the large group praising God together.


It can highlight diversity in a church. Particularly when the choir leads worship from the front of the worship center, the congregation can often see diversity (e.g., age, gender, ethnicity) in front of them. That diversity among the singers is a picture of heaven (Rev 7:9-10).

It helps promote teamwork. That, of course, is the nature of a choir. Everybody has a part, and it's the parts combined that create the overall sound. It seldom hurts for believers to learn to work to-

It offers multi-generational fellowship. I've been to churches where the choir is the only opportunity for several generations to serve together. There's something God honoring about an older saint and a teen believer singing next to one another.

A choir can be an entry-level service opportunity for members and attenders. Any follower of Christ can sing God's praises, including a baby believer who isn't ready yet to serve in other capacities (and, to be frank, a choir helps even the worst voice somehow blend into the praise).

It helps avoid the "single star" approach to worship leadership. That's just naturally the case: Get enough people in the picture, and no single leader becomes the star.
