"The LEADER'S EDGE" by dr. michael bell

Too many pastors, Church business administrators, Church staff, ministry/committee leaders, and small group shepherds attempt to be successful without giving much thought to time, but those who experience increasing ministry effectiveness, respect and honor time in their ministry and personal life.

The Apostle Paul, writing to the churches of Galatia, posits, "Consequently therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all, and especially to those of the household of faith" (Galatians 6:10). The Greek word for "opportunity" means making the most of your time. Time and opportunity are vitally conjoined with success in ministry. In other words, stop procrastinating and seize the moment and act!

know more than a few of you have been to a Church worship service that was scheduled to begin at 10 a.m. and didn't get underway until 10:15 a.m. Or maybe vou've attended a worship service that dragged on and on for 3 or more hours. And, let's not even get started about sermons that seem to go on and on like the Energizer Bunny. I've even known ministry leaders who conducted their meetings as if Chuck Berry's "No Particular Place To Go" was the theme song.

Needless to say, there're lots of different ways to deal with the time-management conundrum. You can download apps, create lists, etc. But if you don't fully understand why it's important for you to better manage your time, those apps and lists aren't going to help you. If you don't have the motivation to use them, you won't.

You have to first look at the big picture. You, personally, as a leader must understand why managing your time (and the time of others) effectively is important, and what you stand to gain from it.

Secondly, you must take responsibility for your use of time. No matter how you slice it, there are only 24 hours in a day. That applies to all of us. The Scriptures challenge us to make the most of the time that




Providence has given us (Ephesians 5:16). As a leader, make a quality decision to take charge of your time. Then, be intentionally aware of how you schedule your meetings, worship services, and, yes, even funerals. I mention funerals because I think it's extremely insensitive for the officiator to "burden the family" with these "marathon" funeral services. (By the way, someone please tell me why there's the need to have these 2-3 minute "Remarks" during the funeral? The Wake was held the previous night - and it went over the time allotted by 30 minutes - and, here it is the day of the funeral and the same folk, who hogged the time at the Wake, feel compelled to occupy center stage once more.)

Another way we can win back our time and improve the quality of our ministries is to seek God's Guidance. Daily inquire of the Lord, asking him to help you identify his dream and design for the ministry he has entrusted you with.

Then, there's the "P" word - PLAN! Stop "winging it" and "playing it by ear." Without a well-thought out and prayed over schedule of weekly, monthly or quarterly goals - dreams can dissipate. Organize your time for maximum productivity and efficiency. Set a schedule, with deadlines, and stick with it. In other words, stay organized! Without organization, you have confusion, which is not of God.

A Daddy's Girl Kind of Life

"And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father." Galatians 4:6

Growing up in South Central L.A. I never had the privilege of my biological father actively in my life. My Mom remarried when I was eight years old and my stepfather assumed a more active role in my life but too often we didn't have the best a relationship. I missed the presence of my father in my life, which I would later learn the negative impact it had in how I related to others. You see the Daddy's girl kind of life I lived was not your typical life. Though there were many major firsts in my life that I wish my father could have celebrated with me, that just never happened. I'm certain others can identify to this "wish" as well.

Through much prayer, wise counsel, and a loving husband, I was able to embrace healing and deliverance from the absence of a natural father to be filled with the presence of an ever present spiritual father, Abba. By the time my natural father and I reconciled our relationship, I had already established solid relationship with Abba.

Abba showed me I was already a Daddy's girl despite the absence of my father. I learned how to activate four principles of a Daddy's girl: 1) Acceptance. Accept the fact that the absence of my father in my life it is not my fault. 2) Forgiveness. Forgive my father for his absence in my life. 3) Wholeness. My father (and mother) gave me life but it is God who completes my life. 4) Celebration. Praise Abba for the unsung heroes, hidden figures if you will, sent by Him in absence of my father to enhance my life.

As I reflect over my life, I give tribute to these heroes who deposited seeds of success in my life to groom me to become the woman I am today. I honor 1) my father for giving me life and his nose (lol); 2) my stepfather for teaching me so many firsts-how to drive my first car (a stick shift mind you), my first music recording, walking me down the aisle; 3) my uncles who exemplified what it means to be faithful and committed to your family; 4) the seminary professor who unlocked the door of my love for theology; 5) the choir director who instilled in me a passion to become a choir director; 6) my one and only spiritual father in the gospel for his wisdom and unfailing support; and 7) my husband who loves me unconditionally. Abba showed me that all of these men were gifts placed in

Cristo Rey Fort Worth High School at Our Mother of Mercy is set to open July 16, 2018. The independent Catholic, faith based school will open to ninth graders of all faiths. It is centrally located in Fort Worth's historic Southside, 1007 E. Terrell Avenue.

Cristo Rey will provide young men and women of Fort Worth with an affordable college preparatory education, coupled with an innovative work study component. Students will attend school for four days and on the fifth day will work in a corporate professional business. That work day will pay for 50 to 60 % of the student's tuition. Approximately 30% of tuition will be paid by contributions from corporate sponsors. The remaining 10%

will be paid parents on a sliding scale, with parent ever paymore ing than \$200 a month.

DESTITUTE. **DESPERATE, AND** INSUFFICIENT: LAY **DOWN YOUR** TALENT

I am the Lord, that is my name; I will not give my glory to another, Nor my praise to graven images (Isaiah

As music ministers, we are accountable to a lot of people. We are accountable to our pastors to run the music ministry as efficiently as possible; to our choir members to respect their time in rehearsal and use it wisely; to the congregation to present songs that minister to the needs of the people, and ultimately, accountable to God. Everything we have belongs to Him, and that includes our musical skill.

But there is another side to what we do - the business side. If you carry the title Minister of Music then you have a say in who gets paid what, and probably have an annual budget to project. My position is that "Minister of Music" and "music minister" are not necessarily one and the same; one is a title, the other is a calling. One requires an anointing from the Holy Spirit, the other merely requires administrative ability. In too many of our churches the person holding the title does not always operate under God's authority. Neither their lives, nor their musical responsibilities reflect the power of God. There are, however, Ministers of Music who do operate under God's authority, and this is evident from the power that exudes from their ministries

As dedicated musicians, we select music, buy it (or write our own), learn it, teach it, re-teach it, plan special events, coordinate with the sound technicians, ensure the instruments are tuned and in good working order, prepare Power Point presentations, and on and on

it goes. And afwe've done all that, we still must prepare for worship. Getting ready for church is one thing; getting ready for worship is something else.



Worship is a matter of the heart and total occupation with God. Musical prac tice and preparation are not preparation for worship. You practiced for hours, but how long did you pray? There are places in God we can only go in the Spirit All our labor won't get us there. To prepare for worship is readying your inner man to meet God and hear Him speak Get past the technology, the rehears als, the planning, and yes, get past the salaries, and prepare for worship.

Choose songs that God wants. It is neither about the music nor people-pleas ing! It's all about Jesus! (Psalm 115:1) Forget your skill and your recognition Worship is not for us - it's for God. Use your instrument to get somebody delivered and snatch them from the fire Ask God to anoint your heart and your hands, in that order, to prophesy or your instrument. The goal in worship is to experience God's glory.

As musicians, and as worshipers, we must come to the point of total insuf ficiency; desperation, if you will, such that we rely on God only (John 15:5(b)) We must lay our talents and our lives a the foot of Jesus and allow Him to teach us. To teach

others we must be teachable ourselves

June is "African-American Music Appreciation Month"

On June 9, 1979 President Jimmy Carter declared the month of June as "Black Music Month" in America. He celebrated the observance with an electrifying concert at the White House that featured some of our greatest music performers. The artists that lit up the presidential ballroom that night included: Billy Eckstine, Sara Jordan Powell, Little Richard, B.B. King, Andrae Crouch, Chuck Berry and Evelyn "Champagne" King. These singers represented music stylings that gave America its musical history foundation.

The African-American music influence has been replicated and acculturated within the American lifestyle and throughout the world. It not only brought forth ingenious talent and compositions, but presented our incomparable culture, language and dress. It is no secret that African-American musicians have been robbed of their songs, property and associated benefits for many years. Proclaiming a month to celebrate, educate and identify our artists is one way to own it for all times. Slaves started our music in this country with the spiritual. They sang spiritual songs in the plantation fields as they worked and even prepared to escape. After the spiritual, the 'blues' was created and is believed to be the tie for all American music. From the blues, we brought iazz, gospel, rock and roll, rhythm and blues and hip-hop music. As a director of both church and community gospel choirs, I have had the pleasure of performing (aka ministering) gospel and spiritual songs on some of the most unique stages not deliberately created for the songs of Zion. When the audiences at gubernatorial events, community festivals, medical conferences, NBA/NFL games, and Fortune 500 company conventions heard the choirs, the connection was sealed in Heaven and on Earth. This is probably why the adage "Music is the universal language" has continued. When music comes from a people who have survived this nation's darkest tragedy, been





The Gospel Corner with Proclaimer of the Word...

Faithful Fathers

Mark 5:22-24, 35-42

I. INTRODUCTION

It has often been stated that men have an enormous impact upon the family structure and the outcome of their children's lives. When our children are placed in the position of growing up too fast, then this causes problems in our society. When a father is not around to nurture the child. then there are relationship issues and stability issues. There are issues such as mental health and the feeling of wanting to have a male presence in a child's life. Sometimes our daughters look for love in the wrong places because their fathers have failed to show them the proper view of love. It is extremely detrimental when young girls do not have enough quality time with their fathers. One study provided information that a girl whose father leaves before she is five years old is eight times more likely to have an adolescent pregnancy than a girl whose father is in the home. The devastation of divorce can adversely affect our children and their understanding of a wholesome relationship.

Boys that are close with their fathers have better attitudes about intimacy and the prospect of a good marital relationship. When boys grow up with only a woman then there are challenges in developing from a boy into a man. It is quite admirable when an uncle or a compassionate male counterpart takes interest in children that are not their biological children. The sperm donor is not the real father but the real father is the one that spends quality time to invest in their children. This type of fatherly attention can help offset the devastation of a broken home. It is extremely important in our churches that our men depict good role models for young boys and young girls. Some homes may not have any good male role models around their children. However, if our young women would take an active role in church life then this may allow the children to see some good role models. As men of today's churches, we must endeavor to let the light of Christ shine in our lives.

When we look at the biblical examples of fathers, we find men such as Abraham, Isaac, Noah, and Moses. Abraham was a tremendous leader with tremendous faith. It is my desire to encourage fathers to be fathers of faith. The story of Isaac is very interesting because he had to follow in the footsteps of his own father who is an example for every generation. If you are blessed to have a father that is well-known and respected, remember that you don't have to feel intimidation but rather exercise a spirit of thankfulness and be what God has called you to be. Isaac was an obedient son and he learned to trust God from his father Abraham. As fathers, we must set a good example for our children so that they can learn to trust the Lord from our examples. The example of Moses should show today's fathers that overwhelming tasks can be achieved if we stay close to God. Despite Moses' busy schedule, he was the father of Gershom and Eliezer. Moses served as a father figure to the entire Hebrew nation. Noah was the kind of father that helped save his family from the destruction of the flood. We need fathers that help save our children from drug ad-



diction, prostitution, and unwholesome behaviors.

As we approach our text, we will find that the Lord can work it out for our fathers if we have the faith to believe. Let's see how the Lord worked it out for Jairus's daughter.

Compassion for the Child; v. 22-24

In these verses, we find a father that is not worried about his job but is concerned about his daughter's well-being. Sometimes fathers are so busy that they cannot see the condition of their own children. In the book of Ephesians, we are encouraged that we should not discourage our children but we should help them along the way. In this passage, Jairus falls at the feet of Jesus and pleads his daughter's case. Jairus tells Jesus, 'My little daughter is dying." "Please come and put your hands on her so that she will be healed and live." All too many times we ignore our children and we do not go to the source of all comfort. It is admirable to state that this father is a worshipper and he falls at the feet of the provider of all healing. When we as fathers recognize the value of worship then we can begin to help our children in the most valuable way. Who do you go to when you don't know what to do? This father takes his case before the Supreme Being of the universe. As fathers, we must stay on our knees for our children. We must plead our children's case before the Lord.

It is nothing wrong with going to the physicians in our society because the Lord gives them knowledge. However, we should come boldly before the throne of grace and present our cases to the Lord in prayer. Anytime we are talking to the Lord, we are actively engaged in a prayer meeting. If the men of our churches would go in prayer for each child of our society, we can effect a change in our children's behavior. If the Lord can get His hands on our children, our children will receive the proper healing. The gang violence may reduce if the fathers are praying. Jairus takes his case to the feet of Jesus.

Sometimes I wonder what would happen for our children if we showed them some compassion in this world. If we as fathers would forget about ourselves and focus on the needs of our children then the world would get better. Our world is sick when children are bullying and killing other children. Now, I must admit that there are some good fathers in this world but we need more good fathers. We need more fathers like Jairus in scripture.

II. Calamity and Concern, v.35-40

In verse 35, we find that the news of the daughter's condition became worse. The bible tells us that she died. Can you imagine the father's heart at the news of

his deceased daughter? When a parent loses a child, it is a most traumatic experience. One cannot imagine the depth of loss when a mother or father loses their child. When we lose people in our lives, we should be encouraged that there is hope in the resurrection. Since Jesus is the hope of the Resurrection, then there is hope for every flower that fades in the garden of life. When loved ones die in the Lord, we who are saved should be encouraged in the faith that all is not lost. We will see our love ones on the other side.

Our Lord and Savior show us what we must do when we get bad news. Jesus tells Jairus in verse 36, "don't be afraid; just believe." Can you trust the Lord vhen vou can't trace Him? Do you believe that Jesus can work it out? In verse 37, we see that Jesus did not let anvone follow Him except for Peter, James, and John. Sometimes as a believer, you may need to block some folks out of your life so that the Lord can work. Sometimes the crowd can mess you up. As believers, we must block out negativity and negative people and focus on the Lord and His will. When Jesus approached the home of Jairus, there was great weeping and wailing for the young daughter because she had just died. In verse 39, Jesus went in and said to them, "Why all this commotion and wailing? The child is not dead but asleep." When the Lord gets his hands on the situation, things can change. Sometimes people worry about what they see instead of focusing on what they believe. Do you believe the Lord can save your children? Do you believe that He is an able God? After Jesus told the people in the home that the child is just asleep, the people laughed at Him.

Afterwards, our Lord Jesus dismissed the crowd surrounding the home. Jesus took the child's father and mother along with His disciples into the room of the deceased daughter.

III. Cure for the Child, v.41-42

In verse 41, we find that Jesus took Jairus' daughter by the hand and told her to get up. The bible tells us that immediately she got up. If the Lord Jesus can raise Jairus' daughter then He can speak to your dead situations and help our children. All hope is not lost. We just need the Lord to get His hands on our children. In closing, please note that with the Lord, all things are possible. As fathers in this generation, let's work our faith in the midst of our trials and tribulations. Our children will have a better chance to succeed in life!




