"The LEADER'S EDGE" by dr. michael bell

Leadership is more than holding a position. Unfortunately, especially in the precincts of the holy, we confuse position, title and authority with leadership. Walk into any organization and ask people to name a leader and the most frequent response will be the name of the CEO or the board chairperson. Walk into any Church and ask people to name a leader and they might point to the Pastor. Maybe? Walk into a ministry meeting and ask "Who's the leader" and those present might respond by calling the name of the ministry coordinator or Ministry Team Representative.

It's true that persons holding elected or appointed positions of authority in a Church can be leaders, and it is certainly true that individuals holding such positions often have more freedom and autonomy to take leader-like actions. Yet, most of us have seen people in such positions who are decidedly not leaders.

I've shepherdized and led four congregations so far over the course of my ministry and I've been guilty of appointing genuinely good people to a position of leadership and, to my chagrin, they became no more than glorified position holders. Leadership is more than huffing and puffing. Leadership is more than posturing and playacting. In fact, leadership is not even an actual position or title. Whether you're a Senior Pastor, ministry coordinator, or chief executive officer of a corporation, your title does not make you a leader. No, you don't suddenly or magically become a leader simply because you have a fancy new title. In fact, you don't need a title to lead.

Leadership happens when people allow you to influence their lives. It's only when your influence causes people to work towards a shared vision that you become a leader. Leadership is more about influence and relationship than it is about holding a position.

When leaders, whether it's a Pastor or a ministry coordinator, fail to lead a lack of focus is inevitable. Effective Church leaders focus intentionally. Leaders are usually distinguished by their ability to



"think big." But as their focus wanes, because of this or that, their thinking shrinks. And, as a result leaders simply lose sight of what's important. When leaders lose focus, then the ministry either stalls or atrophies; sometimes both.

Church leaders are notorious for prioritizing their personal agendas over the mission of the ministries they lead. Here's a 21st century partial explanation for the inertia, the absence of forward progress, many ministries within our Churches are afflicted with: distracted, unfocused leaders. No organization, entity, or ministry can rise above the level of competency of its leadership.


Lack of focus disorients a leader and sets the stage for poor communication. Followers can't possibly understand a leader's intent/vision when the leader isn't even sure what it is! Then, when things go awry, as they sometimes do, distracted, unfocused leaders blame the people they're supposed to be leading for lack of effort or commitment rather than acknowledging their own communication neg-

Effective Church leaders must learn to first communicate with God and then with people. That's the order that will produce the greatest level of effectiveness.

I'll expand on this issue next time if the Lord delays his coming.

A Stand Strong Life By Co-Pastor Yolanda G. Butler

Be on guard. Stand true to what you believe. Be courageous. Be strong." 1 Cor. 16:13 (NLT)

Have there ever been moments in your life in which you feel like giving up? They say you are not supposed to quit but with what is weighing on you right now, you are about to convince yourself that it is just not worth it! You rather stay curled up in your bed and say "Forget it! I QUIT!" Sound familiar? Sure it does. We have all been there, done that.

The Corinthian Epistles were written to encourage believers to remain faithful to the work and call of God. There was much going on in that zealous church including drama, gossip, jealousy, sin, misunderstanding, etc., but not from everyone. There were those who refused to compromise their faith and chose to live a life worthy of the Lord. Paul encouraged the believers to put aside the things that are tripping them up, to stand strong, and be careful not to fall. (1 Cor. 10:12). He exhorts them to walk in five exhortations.

First, "Be on guard." Be diligent to the work of the Lord and be wakeful and alert to who your real spiritual enemies are, for

we wrestle not against flesh and blood but against principalities, powers, the rulers of the darkness of this world and spiritual wickedness in high places. (Eph. 6:12) It's a spiritual warfare not an earthly warfare.

Second, "Stand true to what you believe." Do not be unsettled in your mind. Stand firm in your convictions concerning the truth found in the infallible Word of God. Avoid the need to question everything but rather pray about everything. (Eph. 4:6)

Third, "Be courageous." This is about having an attitude with courage. Courage means to be brave. It is the ability to do something that frightens you. It is moving forward in the strength of the Lord despite the pain and/or grief. You do not have to always try and do everything in your own strength. You have a Father that can demonstrate strength in your weakness (2 Cor. 12:9) and empower you to do all things through Christ. (Philip. 4:13)

Fourth, "Be strong." It is what Zerubbabel understood when he said, "It was not by my might, nor of my own power but only by the Spirit of the Living God that enabled me and the children of Israel to build a great wall despite our weariness, lack and poverty.' As you live for God, determine in your mind not to trust your



own strength or abilities. Rather, totally rely upon the God and the working power of the Holy Ghost. He will supply what you need. You just have to get in position to receive so you can confidently stand strong.

Fifth, "Do everything with kindness and in love." This speaks for itself. Season your life with kindness and love. We do this by first loving God then loving others as we love ourselves. (Mark 12:29-31)

So dear hearts, remember that faith, conviction, courage and love are the essential ingredients for your success and victory to stand strong! Be determined to stand strong.

While I'm waiting, I like to keep BUSY. I prefer busy, as opposed to twiddling my thumbs or letting my mind roam. When I keep busy, I forget that I'm waiting and time goes by faster. Plus, no time is wasted because I'm being productive while I



I remember being in a long slow line at a bank. The guy in front of me was pacing back and forth. He had difficulty being still. He grumbled and complained non-stop. I wanted to shake him and tell him, "get a hold of yourself!" He was freaking out because he didn't know how to wait. He kept thinking about how the delay was setting back the rest of his day, causing him to be late for the next thing on his agenda.

If only the man in line could focus on something besides what he was waiting for. If he could be productive in another area like reading something, placing a phone call, doing some mind exercise, or simply meditating. It would've taken his mind off the wait. Grumbling and pacing did not expedite anything.

Waiting on God can be hard for some people. They grumble and focus on the delay rather than doing something else while they wait. While we wait on the Lord, like Jesus told his servants to, OCCUPY until I return.'

Occupy means to fill or take up space or time. It also means to reside in a place. In the context Jesus is speaking in, it means to keep busy doing kingdom work, be productive and multiply while you wait. Don't sit by idly, doing nothing, pacing or grumbling.

Recently, 'occupy' has taken on some different meanings. There is the 'occupy' movement that started on Wall Street where people use their presence to protest the power of major banks and multinational corporations over the economy. The movement is inspired by popular uprisings in Egypt and Tunisia, and aims to fight back. Occupying empowers change from the bottom up.

Occupy, in the sense of what Jesus wants us to do, we must always be about His business. One of my mantras is 'BE ABOUT IT.' If you keep yourself busy being productive, when Jesus comes through with the promise, it almost feels like a pleasant surprise because you weren't dwelling on it. It's a good distraction from what you're waiting for and time seems to move faster. It makes the wait less boring or mundane.

So don't simply exist, OCCUPY! Make a difference while you wait.







Wait Until the Lord Shows Up Luke 7:11-18

I. INTRODUCTION

There have been many instances in our society that it appears that trouble is on every side. We have civil rights and race relation issues in our country. We are faced with the threat of war from North Korea and possibly China. We have unemployment issues and many people are dissatisfied with the current Presidential administration. We have some environmental issues, yet the Lord is ready and willing to help us. We have seen the recent effects of gun violence along with grief-stricken families. Approximately eighteen schools have been victimized by gun violence in 2018. When we look at the position of the NRA and its interpretation of the Second Amendment, we are troubled. Recently, there was a young man around the age of 18 and he walked into a school with an assault weapon and killed innocent children in Parkland Florida. However, to the credit of the young people in Parkland Florida, a cry went out for help. On February 23, 2018, CNN hosted an anti-gun town hall meeting featuring many grieving children and parents from Stoneman Douglas High School in Parkland, Florida. We do know that from this meeting, there were expressions of banning assault weapons from public use. There has been communication regarding improved background checks, a better reporting system, better law enforcement reaction to threats, and more community involvement.

We are reminded from Psalms 46:1 that God is our refuge and a very present help in the time of trouble. Our God can provide a place of refuge for our children and school administrators. Although our children may be in harm's way at times, the Lord can strengthen our communities, cities, and country to enact laws to protect our schools. We must pray for our community leaders and do what we can to seek a brighter day. After we have done all that we can do, we must stand and wait until the Lord shows up.

When we turn our attention to the Holy Scriptures, we find examples of how to deal with trouble. Threats and rumors of wars are not a new experience, but these things existed in biblical times. When I think about the threats that went out against the Israelites. our God had a reputation for showing up at the right time. In Exodus 3:1-14, we find that God had a message of deliverance for Moses. The Lord said that I have seen the affliction of my people and I am coming to deliver them. One might say that the Lord showed up on behalf of the Israelites. As believers, we can be assured that the Lord will show up on time for our behalf. In 2 Kings 20:1-6, we find that Hezekiah was sick unto death, but the Lord was not through with him yet. No matter how bleak it may appear, our God can deliver on time. The Lord is an on-time God. We must not throw in the towel and act as if there is no hope. As fellow citizens of this country, we must continue to strive for a better day for our children, our communities, our churches, our cities, and our country.

As we approach our text, we will find that if the Lord shows up, He will bring about a change. Let's see what the Lord tells us re-



garding our current trials and tribulations.

II. A Word to the Widow Woman; v. 11-13

As we look at the earlier verses, we find in the verses 1-10, Jesus spoke a Word of healing regarding the centurion's servant. The place of this passage is in Capernaum. This was a place that Jesus performed many miracles. The servant was very dear to his master and he was ready to die. The bible tells us that the centurion heard that Jesus was passing by that the centurion sent the elders of the Jews unto Jesus. The request from the centurion to the elders was for healing his servant. It is admirable that the centurion was a Gentile, but he felt that if Jesus could get His hands on the matter then his servant would be healed. This is a word to us in our troubled times. The bible tells us in Luke 7:10 that the servant was found whole that was sick. With economic difficulties, school shootings, and racial tensions, our God can make the situation whole. Do you want the Lord's help? I recommend to you that the Lord is not through yet. In verses 11-13, we find our Lord continuing His good works.

Our text takes us to a place called Nain. When one looks at Nain, one must consider that it was close to Capernaum. Yet, we find the Lord Jesus going about doing good works from place to place. It was the next day after the miracle at Capernaum that Jesus approached the funeral procession. As residents of our country, we must seek to do some good everywhere we go. Since Christ is our example and we are Christ-like, we must do some good works. We must let our light shine in this dark world so that others might know the Savior.

As the funeral procession was in process, Jesus approached a woman that had lost her only child in the prime of his life. In early biblical days, the husband was a source of comfort to the wife. However, if the husband died, then the son became a source of comfort. In this text, we find that there was a widow woman that had lost her husband and now she is about to bury her dead son. In verse 13, the Lord took notice of the widow woman and her grief. Jesus said, "Weep not." This is a word to the widow woman. Jesus was getting ready to do something about her dead situation.

III. A Word to the Son, v.14-15

It is in these verses that we find that Jesus stopped the funeral procession and the men laid down the casket of the young son. Man's extremities are God's opportunities. When you get to your wits end, God know how to stop a pity party. In verse 14, Jesus spoke to the young man and He said, "Arise". When the Lord speaks, things will

happen. There is about to be a change. When the Lord saved us from a burning hell, the Holy Spirit brought about a wonderful change. I no longer walk the way I used to walk. I no longer talk the way I used to talk. If the Lord has brought about a change in your dead situation, you ought to tell him thank you. There have been many people that have been on hospice and the doctors gave them up. But the Lord, allowed them to live a little while longer. I am simply suggesting to you that when you have done all you can do, then you should simply trust the Lord. Can you trust the Lord when you can't trace Him? Our cries should be put in check when we look at Christ's compassion. Jesus had compassion on the widow woman and He spoke deliverance from death to her son. The young man lived a little while longer. He could continue giving comfort to his mother. Are you giving comfort to your widow mother? Are you giving comfort to your divorced mother? Are you helping somebody along the way?

Sometimes situations in life may appear dead. Regardless of one's effort, eagerness, or earnestness, the situation appears hopeless. There are times that it doesn't matter how much you push or pull; the situation appears dead. Sometimes churches appear dead but when the Lord shows up, things change. The marriage appears dead. The friendships appear dead. The family appears dead. The job is a dead-end job with no prospects of no growth. The ministry appears dead. However, when the Lord shows up, He can call the dead back to life. Our text shows how the Lord can speak and things change. Jesus said to the young man, "Arise." How many times have the Lord intervened in your dead situation?

IV. A Word to the Witnesses, v.16-18

After Jesus raised the dead man from the coffin, then there was a great astonishment on the crowd. They were all struck with wonder at this miracle and they begin to give God the glory. The Lord and his goodness, as well as the Lord and his greatness, are to be reverenced. The witnesses of the miracle begin to talk among themselves and say that the Lord has visited His people. Are you a witness of the Lord's goodness in the land of the living? Are you ready to run and tell of the goodness of the Lord? Has the Lord done anything for you? Sometimes we need to share our testimonies with someone else. Sometimes our testimonies can shed light on someone else's dead situation. In closing, make sure that your life gives God the glory! The Lord is the Lord of the Resurrection. He can bring dead situations back to life.
