"The LEADER'S EDGE" by drmichaelbell

Not too long ago, I reviewed policies and procedures with the church's leadership team. Policies and procedures provide a clear framework for meeting ministry objectives and help ensure that quality systems and processes support the way ministry is carried out. When thoughtfully developed and consistently followed, they strengthen both accountability and effectiveness in the life of the church.



Having solid policies and procedures in place at your church, first and foremost, protects those you serve, including children, youth, and vulnerable adults. Second, they protect those who serve, volunteers, staff members, and the church as a whole. A written policy establishes expectations for employee and volunteer conduct, while procedures outline the specific steps required to carry those expectations into practice. Clearly defined policies and procedures also become especially important during seasons of leadership transition. When practices are documented, the church avoids confusion, minimizes misunderstandings, and maintains continuity of ministry.

Policies and procedures serve different but complementary purposes. A policy is a statement that defines authority, establishes boundaries, assigns responsibilities and provides guidelines for carrying out the work of the church. In simple terms, policies clarify who performs a task, why it is done and under what conditions it is done. Procedures, on the other hand, explain how the task is completed. While a church policy guides expectations and ensures compliance, a procedure provides the practical "how to" that enables ministry to function consistently and responsibly.

Policies and procedures must also be church specific. They should be tailored to reflect a congregation's leadership structure, facility layout, ministries offered, age groups served, volunteer expectations and operational realities. Churches don't have to reinvent the wheel or begin from scratch, but policies must be contextually adapted so they address the unique character, mission and needs of each congregation.

Here are several essential policies that every church should consider

implementing. Although the specific content will vary from church to church, these areas are foundational for a healthy and well-governed ministry:

- **Child and Youth Protection and Safety Policies.** This policy establishes safeguards to protect children, youth, and vulnerable adults while providing clear expectations for screening, supervision, and reporting procedures that also protect volunteers and staff.

- **Church Financial Policy.** A financial policy outlines how donations are received, recorded, safeguarded, and used, promoting faithful stewardship, transparency, accountability, and trust within the congregation.

- **Facility Use Policy.** A facility use policy defines how church property may be used and outlines expectations for access, approved activities, setup and cleanup, safety requirements, and responsibility for church resources. All use should align with the church's mission and values.

- **Church Communication Policy.** A communication policy establishes how and through what channels information is shared, ensuring announcements and ministry updates are communicated clearly, consistently, and responsibly.


Strong policies and procedures are not barriers to ministry; they are safeguards that support it. When churches establish thoughtful policies and practical procedures, they create an environment where mission and ministry can flourish "decently and in order."

Speak Life Thought

with Dr. Yolanda G. Butler

A Life of Faith to Love Others--but it hurts!

"The first time I was brought before the judge, no one came with me. Everyone abandoned me. May it not be counted against them. But the Lord stood with me and gave me strength..."

As Apostle Paul gives his final words to his spiritual son, Pastor Timothy, he shares a "church hurt" moment in which fellow laborers abandoned the faith and attacked his ministry. By his words, you can sense hurt, but he did not allow the fruit of bitterness to linger in his heart. He had the faith to pray for those who abandoned the faith and attacked him. He had the faith to believe that God would vindicate him and give him strength to continue. He had the faith to forgive (a byproduct of love). He had the faith to believe that he would keep the faith, finish his course, and see Jesus in glory.

Have you ever been hurt by those whom you have helped, mentored, labored with, supported, paid their bills, visited in the hospital, defended them before others, loved unconditionally, or sacrificed for? Have you lost someone because of an accident, illness, violence, or divorce? Has someone abruptly walked out of your life with no explanation? Has someone dear to your heart passed away? Oh, I can feel you, dear hearts, as you say, "Yes, Dr. Butler, that is me." Then it is

safe to say you can identify when I say, "I have the faith to love, but it hurts—it hurts real bad."

Hurt is a result of some action that has invaded your life, causing physical or emotional pain and injury. We understand that we are to love our enemies, bless those who wish evil against us, do good to those who hate us, and pray for those who threaten, mistreat, and harass us (Matt 5:43-44). The only human way we can do this is through the abiding love of Christ. This is faith to love even when it hurts.

But I feel the need to encourage those who experience a different kind of hurt that makes you want to crawl under a rock and hide in a place where no one can find you. The same faith (trust in God) to love (giving selflessly) those who hurt you is the same faith to love that is needed to help you through the overwhelming hurt in your heart.

Recently, I comforted someone going through a "faith to love, but it hurts" uncommon season with these words and scriptures:

It's okay to cry unto the Lord. "Cry unto the Lord. He hears you from His Holy Hill." (Psalm 3:4)

He is your hope. "Why am I discouraged? Why is my heart so sad? I will put my hope in God! I will praise him again—my Savior and my God." (Psalm 42:11)

Give it all to the Father: "Give all your worries and cares to God, for He cares about you." (1 Peter 5:7)



Trust God to pull you through: "The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; My God, my strength, in whom I will trust; My buckler, and the horn of my salvation, and my high tower." (Psalm 18:2)

Reach out on borrowed faith. When you have no strength and your faith is weak, reach out to someone and say, "Can I borrow your faith to carry me through until I can regain strength? (Mark 5:36 "But Jesus overheard them and said to Jairus, "Don't be afraid. Just have faith.")

So dear hearts, be determined not to hold all that unhealthy hurt in your heart. Let not bitterness take root. Choose to detox it through the word to fuel your faith to love even though it hurts.

The Honorable Gyna Bivens... "Gone but never Forgotten"



The Honorable Gyna Mabelle Bivens, beloved family member, friend, and community leader, entered rest Monday, February 9, 2026, leaving behind a lasting impact on all who knew her. Known for her warmth, generosity, and unwavering dedication, Gyna touched many lives through her kindness and compassionate spirit. Before her career in government and nonprofit leadership, Bivens excelled in media and corporate communications. She began back in Fort Worth, she worked at KKDA-AM (Soul 73) as news anchor; KBOX-KMEZ,

and KRLD-AM News Radio in Dallas as assignment editor; and later served as Bureau Chief for Dallas's FOX 4 News. Her corporate career included serving as a spokesperson and municipal liaison for Oncor Electric and as a Public Information Manager for the City of San Antonio, where she led crisis communications and launched Texas's first municipal cable access television program.

She served for 12 years as the representative of Fort Worth's City Council District 5 being elected in 2013 through 2025. She earned a reputation for championing community-driven growth and equitable economic development. In 2021 Mayor Mattie Parker appointed Bivens as Mayor Pro Tem honoring her as the "Dean of the Council."

Born and raised in Fort Worth, Gyna excelled academically and was a 1973 graduate of Dunbar High School. She attended Texas Wesleyan College, and earned a bachelor's degree in broadcast media from North Texas State University. Thus began a storied



career in communications that would have a profound impact on the surrounding community. In addition to her public service, Bivens served as President and Executive Director of North Texas LEAD, a nonprofit established by eight Fort Worth CEOs to advance the careers of college-degreed professionals.

She was preceded in death by her father, Reverend Roy W. Bivens, Sr.; brothers, Roy Bivens, Jr. and Michael Baker, Sr.; and grandmother, Sadie Baker.

Gyna is survived by her beloved mother, Betty Joyce Bivens; brothers, Reverend Waylon Bivens, Sr. and Charles Baker, Jr. (Nedra); sister, Melanie Cherice Bivens; uncle, Howard Lee Green, Sr.; several generations of cousins, nephews, nieces, other family members; a host of colleagues, neighbors and friends.

Richard Smallwood (November 30, 1948 – December 30, 2025) was an American gospel artist who formed the Richard Smallwood Singers in 1977 in Washington, D.C.

Life and career of Richard Smallwood, Gospel Artist

Richard Smallwood graduated cum laude from Howard University with a dual B.A. degree in classical vocal performance and piano, in addition to graduate work in the field of ethnomusicology. Smallwood was a member of the Celestials, the first gospel group at Howard University. The group was the first gospel act to appear at Switzerland's Montreux Jazz Festival. Smallwood was also a founding member of the university's first gospel choir.



Smallwood's recording career began in 1982 with the album The Richard Smallwood Singers. The album spent 87 weeks on Billboard's gospel chart. Its follow-up, Psalms, was nominated for a Grammy Award. Two years later his Textures album was also nominated. Textures included the song "Center Of My Joy" which was written by Smallwood with Bill and Gloria Gaither. Smallwood won his first Grammy Award, along with a Dove Award, for his production on the Quincy Jones and Mervyn Warren album Handel's Messiah: A Soulful Celebration.

Smallwood's music has been recorded by many artists

including Destiny's Child, Yolanda Adams, and Karen Clark-Sheard. He accompanied opera singer Leontyne Price at a Christmas celebration at the White House during the Reagan administration. Smallwood, with his group Vision, recorded several successful projects for the Verity label. He finished his master's degree in divinity from Howard University in 2004 and was inducted into the Gospel Music Hall of Fame in 2006.

One of his concerts was recorded live at the Hammerstein Ballroom at the Manhattan Center in New York. The concert features guests Kim Burrell on "Journey". Kelly Price on "Morning's Breaking", Chaka Khan on "Precious Is Your Name", as well as the Hawkins Family, Tramaine Hawkins, and the original roster of singers who comprised both the Richard Smallwood Singers and Vision. Aretha Franklin and the Clark Sisters contributed to additional studio tracks on the album.

Among Smallwood's most popular songs are "Total Praise", composed in 1996 while he was experiencing sorrow in his life, and "I Love the Lord", popularized by singer Whitney Houston in the film The Preacher's Wife.

Smallwood died in Sandy Spring, Maryland, on December 30, 2025, due to kidney failure at the age of 77.

Our Statement on the Passing of Iconic Civil Rights Leader The Rev. Jesse L. Jackson.



I was a young admirer of Rev. Jesse Jackson long before I ever had the honor of meeting him. I vividly remember his visit to what was then North Texas State University—now University of North Texas—during his 1988 presidential campaign. As a student leader, I sat captivated, listening to a man who spoke with prophetic fire and pastoral compassion.

That same year, his address at the Democratic National Convention was nothing short of historic—one of the most powerful speeches of that generation. It remains a masterclass in moral clarity, courage, and conviction, and it is still worth revisiting today (<https://youtu.be/nGJ7btYJPPA?si=GcMILw1hORR-USOb>).

Over the years, I had the privilege of witnessing his leadership up close. He was brilliant yet accessible, bold yet deeply spiritual. He carried the cadence of the Black

church into the corridors of power and reminded America that justice is not a political slogan—it is a moral obligation. He challenged systems while shepherding souls. He confronted injustice while calling the nation higher.

My last personal memory of him is one I will forever treasure. On May 24, 2022, as I prepared to travel to Uvalde following the devastating mass shooting, I received a call from Houston civil rights leader Dr. Candice Matthews with Rev. Jackson on the line. In that moment of grief and urgency, he offered me a simple yet profound directive:

“Tatum, don’t be political—be spiritual.”

Those words settled my spirit. They clarified the difference between reacting for attention and responding with leadership. In a moment when cameras, commentary, and controversy could have taken center stage, he reminded me that true leadership begins in the soul. He reminded me that our first responsibility is not to posture—but to pray, to serve, and to stand in moral authority.

Rev. Jesse L. Jackson was a warrior for justice, but he was also a shepherd of conscience. He marched. He organized. He negotiated. But above all, he believed. He believed that faith must fuel freedom and

that our public witness must be rooted in spiritual conviction.

We thank God for his life, his labor, and his legacy.

Sleep well, fellow warrior. And if the Lord should return before we gather again, I will see you on the other shore.






