

"The LEADER'S EDGE" by dr. michael bell

There's a lot to be said for the power of consistency. Have you ever heard the phrase "consistent action leads to consistent results?" Whether you're talking about the sacred or the secular, the Church or culture, the marketplace or the public square, it takes consistency if you're going to accomplish your dreams. To put it another way, if you don't stick with it - forget it. It's not enough to start out good or even to do well for a hot minute or two if somewhere along the way you drop out of the race, take a detour, throw in the towel and quit, deciding the commitment called for more than you were willing to give.

Inconsistency is the seedbed for the death of a Church. Let a little inconsistency creep into a Church, and it won't be long before complacency sets Church leaders are inconsistent our are you mentoring? leadership is less effective. Inconsistency is an Achilles heel for many A leader must be predictable, as conleaders, and can even compromise the sistency and predictability are positive mission and ministries of the Church.

Some of the common areas in which we tend to be inconsistent are:

1. Not following through on commitments. We make commitments, promises, claims, and decrees, but seldom follow through. This is a problem of inconsistency. As a coach of other leaders, I've seen the effects of inconsistent leadership. As a pastor, I've seen the consequences of inconsistent ministry leaders. You know what's really frustrating? Leaders who swear up and down that they are committed to leading their ministry but fail to follow through on anything they've said they would do.

2. Not maintaining your mission and vision. When you as the leader and you neglect the Church's mission and vision, you're guilty of inconsistency. One of the most detrimental leader in any Church is the solo leader who has gone rogue. What do I mean? I'm talking about the leader who refuses to be shepherdized and is determined to mis-lead the small group or ministry he or she has been assigned to lead by ignoring Church protocol, not paying conducts leadership seminars and attention to leadership criteria, and dis-



count the Church's Mission and Vision Statements. This type of leader is a Nightmare On Any Street!

3. Not mentoring those you minister alongside. Mentoring people is part of your mandate as an effective leader. If you're a small group or Sunday School teacher, you should be mentoring a fuin and apathy rears its head. When ture teacher. If you are a deacon, who

> traits that provide stability for the institution, group or organization. Consistency builds trust. As a successful leader your word must be trusted. If you say you're going to do something, you have to do it. If you plan to meet somewhere, you need to be there. When an individual in a leadership position doesn't act or behave in a consistent manner, the people around him or her don't know what to expect.

Here are three key areas where consistency makes the difference between bad, good, and great leadership: (A) Consistency of Time. Understanding the value of your time and everyone else's time matters. (B) Consistency of Study. Leaders never stop learning and learners never stop studying. Once you think you know all you need to know you are arrogant and irrelevant. (C) Consistency of Authenticity. To phrase it another way, always be genuine and real.

I pray that you become determined to become rooted in God by Christ Jesus that is planted by rivers of Living Water of the Holy Spirit and begin to demonstrate the Kingdom of God to its fullest.

I absolutely love what is about to happen musically for the next 60 days. November starts the holiday specific songs we'll hear celebrating our Sovereign God and His blameless Son for their love and sacrifice. 

Lost but Found Mark 10:46-52

1. Introduction

It has been stated by the great songwriter John Newton that he was a great sinner, but Christ is a great Savior. On March 21, 1748, John Newton became a changed man. He recognized that God could take a rude, profane, slave-trading sailor and transform him into a child of God. John Newton had a reputation as a very rough sailor with a fowl mouth. It was on the slave ship named Greyhound, that the Lord rescued John Newton. The turmoil on the Greyhound was gut-wrenching and thought-provoking. It looked like all was lost. The ship was tossed and driven by an angry wind. Out of nowhere God stepped in and the ship did not perish. I am sure when John Newton surveyed the canvas of his life, he felt his life was like the fate of that ship. Later. John Newton wrote the most famous hymn of all time, "Amazing "I once was lost but now I am Grace." found.'

The song, Amazing Grace is song in nearly every church in America. It has been widely published throughout the annals of time. The words bring great relief to a sinner lost on the seashores of life. In Romans 3:10, we are reminded that we have all sinned and come short of the glory of God. As humans, we are challenged with the sin nature at birth. We come into this world lost in sin and in dire need of a Savior. John Newton is not the only one that needed a Savior. All have sinned, and everybody stands in need of salvation. If you are reading this article, there is good news. There is a cure for man's lost condition. Jesus can save from the gutter most to the uttermost.

Have you ever been lost while driving your car? How did you feel? The issue of being lost is a miserable condition. Well, allow me to comfort the common student of driving. If one can find the right compass, then one can find right direction for one's life. Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ is the right compass for lost sinners in this world. Will you allow the Lord to navigate your life so that you can avoid the penalty of sin? Life without God is like a ship that is out on the raging sea with no help in sight. Today, we thank the Lord for the life of John Newton. Although, he experienced a life changing moment on the sea, we can experience a life changing moment on the dry land of America.

As we delve into the text, we will find that a man was blind from birth, but the Lord worked it out for him. Let's see how the Lord worked it out for blind Bartimaeus.



2. The Blind Man's Condition, v.46-48

In these verses we find that a man is born blind from birth. How tragic it is for one to have never seen the light of day! This man's name was Bartimaeus and he had a condition that left him begging for help. We must be careful how we treat those of society that are left to beg for help. We must be careful how we treat that caravan of Central American migrants that are seeking a better day for their families in America. The group has already travelled about 30 miles per day since forming in Honduras. Many of these Central American migrants are fleeing the violence and widespread poverty in their country. We must find a peaceable way to allow these migrants to apply for refugee status and continue their journey.

As we take a deeper look at the blind beggar, we ascertain that he couldn't work for a living. He had to beg. I am sure that when one cannot work, it is a miserable condition. Everyone that is out of work is not seeking a handout, but some may just desire a hand up. If we could insure that our children could get an education, then we could position our children for a better day. There are a lot of blind people in America today. People are blind when racist antics are tolerated and sometimes encouraged by some people in our country. We are lost and walking in darkness when we fail to meet the needs of those who truly need help. When blind Bartimaeus heard that Jesus was passing by, he cried out for help. Our Lord hears us when we cry ready to be delivered from life's strugunto Him. Our God is an able God that can perform miracles in our lives. Blind Bartimaeus knew that if he could get in touch with Jesus, everything would be alright. The plea for help is observed in Mark 10:47. The blind man began to shout, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" There is a cry in our country for help and compassion. There are hurting people everywhere along the shoreline of life. There is hope for the hopeless!

3. The Blind Man's Comfort, v. 49-50

It is good to know that if we call on the Lord, then the Lord can answer our prayers. The blind man called upon

the Lord to have mercy on him. In verse 49, Jesus stopped walking and said, "Call him." The bible informs us that they spoke to the blind man and said, "Cheer up." On your feet! He's calling you. The people around this blind man had some compassion for this blind beggar. They gave blind Bartimaeus some good news. Jesus is calling you. Anytime the Lord hears our prayer request. He can make a difference in our lives. In verse 50, we find that the blind man threw his cloak to the ground and came to Jesus. How did you come to the Lord? One song writer tells us, that I was weary, wounded, and sad. I found a resting place in my Lord. If we cast our burdens upon the Lord, then He will be a sweet old resting place. Have you made your prayer request known unto the Lord? Blind Bartemaeus received some comfort when the Lord told him to come unto Him.

4. The Blind Man's Cure, v. 51-52

In verse 51, we find that Jesus asked blind Bartemaeus a question. "What do you want me to do for you? The blind man said, "Rabbi, I want to see." When we approach the Lord in faith, our God will respond to our faith. Have you sought the Lord in faith? Do you believe that God is able? When we look at verse 52, we find that Jesus informs the blind man that his faith has healed him. This is good news to know that faith can move mountains in our lives. Our faith can move the mountains of despair, discouragement, and a defeated lifestyle.

When the blind man received his sight, we find that he followed Jesus along the road. When the Lord saves us from our sins, we will want to follow the Lord. When the Lord saves us, we will have a new talk and a new walk. If the Lord has done something for you, then you will experience a change in your conduct, character, and life's conditions. It doesn't matter what the problems may be, our Lord can change your life for the better. Let's encourage each other in the faith because faith gave blind Bartimaeus his sight. We walk by faith and not by sight. Let's continue to walk the good walk of faith and get
