"The LEADER'S EDGE" by dr. michael bell

My very first Church was filled with people who'd been converted from another faith community that was radically different from mainstream Christianity. They'd come from an obscure religious group that was built on a different system of beliefs than those embraced and taught by the traditional Baptist Church I was called to shepherdize.

When I arrived, the congregation was a "hot mess." Almost immediately, from jumpstreet, I identified with Titus in Crete. You will remember from your personal devotional reading that Titus clearly had his hands full in Crete. The churches in Crete had a major authority problem and were prone to false teaching, among other things. And, to his credit, Titus had an unusual knack for dealing with Church difficulties, charlatans, and divisive members. So, I read, studied and taught Titus often during my tenure at this Southeast Washington D.C. congregation.

From my first Church and the subsequent ones, I've learned some principles about dealing with difficult people. Here are a few of them:

1. Pray. Prayer is not asking for my will, whim or way to be done but for God's will. It's asking for wisdom, discernment, courage, grace, and patience, which we especially need in working with difficult people.

2. Work with those you can. Seek those who love the Lord and his truth and are committed to the Church's well-being.

3. Preach the Word of God redemptively. Thoughtful preaching has great potential for helping difficult people mature in their faith and grow in Christlikeness. It also builds up those who have a deep commitment to God's truth so that they can come alongside you and work with difficult people in the Church.

4. Be honest but discreet. Don't gossip about difficult people, but be willing to humbly yet directly confront or "care-front" them in the hope that they might change



or leave.

5. Take the long view. Realize that we're only part of God's plan for the Church. One person plants, another waters, but it is God who gives the increase.

6. Remember the people belong to God. Sometimes pastors, leaders, and members refer to the people as "my church," but we know they belong to God, not us. Therefore, we can commit them to God knowing that God works all things together according to his good purpose.

7. Trust in God. Someone has said, "God is the cure-giver; I am only the care-giver." This perspective enables us to trust that God will act as he desires for their good and the greater good of the church.

8. Learn from experience. A wise somebody once said, "Personal experience is the only kind I've ever had." So don't apologize for experience, including mistakes, but learn from it, knowing that God uses our personal experience as training ground for future encounters.

All ministry, including working with difficult people, is God's work. For this we can be truly grateful, even if it's sometimes frustrating and we don't always understand what's happening. After all, it's not about us, it's about God.

A Life of Integrity

"Live well for the Master, making Him proud of you." (Col. 1:10 Msg)

Do you ever battle with staying focused, balanced, or determined? I must admit that there are times in which I battle emotionally to stay focused and balanced. Life, pressure, demands, unexpected happenings, change, to name a few, can trigger an emotional battle, but perhaps I'm not alone. It is why the Holy Spirit birthed a passion of prayer in me as a defense mechanism against emotional overload.

As an Assistant Pastor, I share the burden of ministry with my husband, the Senior Pastor. He trusts me to handle many administrative aspects of the ministry, which help to maintain spiritual and natural order for the church ministry we are called to serve. This is what we have been known for since our establishment, and one of which I have found over the years some are not comfortable with and actually run away from. The Bible declares that in everything that we do we are to do it heartily as unto the Lord knowing that our greater reward flows from Him. (See Col. 3:23-25) He has also instructed us to do all things decently and in order. (1 Cor. 14:40)

I am gifted in administration by

gift and talent. Disorder makes me nervous and anxious, and if I am not careful, a spirit of disappointment and frustration will try to rise up within me. Rather than walk in a spirit of excellence, I find myself walking in a spirit of stress. I have learned that in order to maintain a good attitude in all that I do for the Kingdom to not neglect my temple work. Temple work is daily maintenance of the whole you. It involves prayer, meditation of God's word, worship, a balanced diet, exercise, and proper sleep. I know this can be challenging but you owe it to yourself if you are going to be a focused, balanced and determined Kingdom worker, who is mandated to live a life of integrity and order. It will be very difficult for the Father to entrust you with handling His people and His affairs when your life is raggedy, finances are jacked up, household is a mess, lifestyle is wacked, and you have a problem with submission.

You see dear hearts, staying focused, balanced and determined mandates you surrender (submit) your entire being to the Father that can be molded, shaped and reshaped into a vessel that will give Him glory. (2 Tim 2:20-21) When you can submit to the loving and capable hands, instructions, correction, and praises of the Father then you will have no problem submitting to the delegated authority He has estab-



lished here on this earth to help guide you, shepherd you, direct you, caution you, warn you, encourage you, and yes promote you to your next level. (Read Zep. 3:17; Heb. 13:17-18) The Father will open their spiritual eyes to see things within you that you have not been able to see clearly. The Apostle Paul, Spiritual Father to Pastor Timothy, reminded him he was accountable by God for those he laid hands on and promoted within the church. (1 Tim 5:22) This is a clear instruction to us to as believers to trust God's timing, learn how to wait, take the time to build on the whole you, learn from your mistakes, put aside those things that are not godly, and endeavor to walk worthy of the calling that is in you focused, balanced and determined.

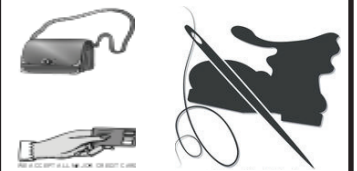

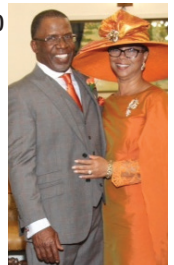

The Writing on the Wall

Daniel 5:1-31

1. Introduction

If one says that the writing is on the wall, then there are obvious signs that a situation is going to become very difficult or unpleasant. These signs may indicate a desperate, dire, and disappointing season is on the way. When God instructs us in His Word and we continue to ignore His warnings, then God will bring about a change. In Jeremiah 25:8-9, the Lord God told Jeremiah that because Israel has not obeyed my words, then I will use King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon as my servant to discipline the land. It was foretold by the prophet Jeremiah that Israel would go into 70 years of captivity for their neglect of God's Word. It is important to state that sin does not go unnoticed by God. Israel had a reputation for getting in trouble with God. In America, we have not always listened to the Lord God. Yet, God has graced America with a beautiful country where immigrants should be allowed to enter the land. In Proverbs 14:34, we read, "Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people." If we choose to walk in darkness then we are a reproach to the land.

As a nation, we have allowed satanic influences to govern our lawmaking abilities. There are people in this country that would sacrifice the honor of women just to hold a political office. If the Senate passes the nomination of Brett Kavanaugh to become the next Supreme Court Justice in America, then we have a problem. If men can possibly sexually assault women in this country and run for one of the highest positions, there is a moral problem. When the objectives of a political party take precedence over prestige and honor, we are in a dire situation. As we delve into the text, we will find that governments may come and go but the Word of God stands forever. King Nebopolassar of Babylon defeated the Assyrian army which had previously captured the Northern Kingdom of Israel due to their disobedience. King Nebopolassar was the father of King Nebuchadnezzar. Later, we find that the southern kingdom of Israel had sinned against God and the Lord God decided to use King Nebuchadnezzar to discipline them. The prophet Jeremiah foretold that the captivity of the southern kingdom would last only 70 years and afterwards they would regain their freedom. The captivity of Israel is stated in Jeremiah 25:11 and the release of the Jews is foretold in Jeremiah 29:10. Although the Babylonians ruled over the southern kingdom of Israel for 70 years, we know from biblical history that the Persian ruler came into power after the 70 years. Our lesson will give insight into how the Persians came into power. Today, we must continue to acknowledge that God is still on the throne and He is fully aware of any captivity that His people may experience. Let's see how the Lord God worked it out for the southern kingdom of Israel (Judah). Our God can work out any captivity on behalf of His people. God can deliver on time!

2. Excitement for the Day, v.1-4

It is here that we find that King Belshazzar the king of Babylon made a great feast. It was indeed an idolatrous and sacrilegious party. This was a party that was put together by a pagan king that wanted to celebrate either his birthday, or coronation-day, or in honor of some of his idols. There was an excess of wine and women. To make matters



worse, King Belshazzar gave the command to bring out the sacred gold and silver vessels from the temple to use for drinking. It is dangerous to misuse anything or anyone that is sacred unto the Lord God. King Cyrus possibly received the 411 on this party. Many biblical historians state that king Cyrus and his army was standing outside the gates and about to besiege the city while the party was in progress. We never know what may happen within a day and this is why the body of Christ must stay prayed up! The bible tells us that a haughty spirit before a fall and pride before destruction. King Belshazzar had fallen into a state of pride. His head was giddy and his heart was merry with wine. The king was now in a good frame of mind to praise the wrong gods. The king and his lords, and his women began to praise the gods of gold and silver and the gods of wood and stone in their drunken state. We know as a body of baptized believers that praises are due only to our Lord and Savior.

The king and his men were now buried in sleep and wine. Most of us are familiar with what can happen when one consumes too much liquor. When this state of drunkenness occurs, it can cause one to become quite sleepy. Today, it appears that the conscience of this country has fallen into a state of sleepiness. However, I urge each person of respectable character to go out and vote in the midterm elections. Prayerfully, the next leaders will help to awaken this country out of the sleep of discrimination, murder, incest, and rape. When King Belshazzar fell into sleep, he was just ripe for destruction because the enemy was standing outside his gates. We must awaken out of sleep so that the enemy will not catch us off-guard. We must not allow the devil to fulfill his mission statement which includes killing, stealing, and destroying innocent lives.

3. Emotional Distress, v. 5-16

In verses 5-9, we ascertain that an alarm is given to King Belshazzar in the form of the handwriting on the wall. When the Lord God gets ready to bring about a change, He can step in on time. The time was now up for Judah's captivity. Prior to Judah's captivity, it had been prophesied by Jeremiah that the Lord God would bring His people out of bondage in 70 years. It would have behooved King Belshazzar to engage in a public prayer meeting for his kingdom but he was too full of himself that he needed something to get his attention.

In verse 5, there appeared the fingers of a man's hand writing on the plaster wall before the king's face. The doom of Babylon was now being written on the wall. There was no noise made to frighten King Belshazzar out of his drunken state. There were no claps of thunder or flashes of lighting. There was no destroying angel with a sword drawn in his hand. It was only handwriting on the wall. It was near the candlestick. God's Word can cause the vilest sinner to go into a state of fright. The king

saw the part of the hand that wrote but he did not see the person whose hand it belonged to. The king is immediately moved with a state of fear. The king's own guilty conscience began to bother him. In verse 7, the king cried out for help. He called for his astrologers and soothsayers but none could read the writing on the wall. Can you read the handwriting on today's wall? Are you concerned about the recent tragedies and events in our land? What is the meaning of the hurricanes and winds that gripped the east coast this year? In verse 10, the queen told her son that she knows a man that could interpret the handwriting on the wall. She told her son, King Belshazzar that there is a man in whom the Spirit of God dwells. The queen mother told King Belshazzar to call Daniel into the royal palace. It is sometimes funny how we can go to the wrong people for advice but who has sought the Lord for advice? In verse 13, Daniel was brought in before the king. If wisdom would have prevailed in King Belshazzar's lifetime, he would have had Daniel near him. However, it appears that King Belshazzar did not even know Daniel. Daniel is nearly 90 years old at the time of this event. Daniel had an humble, holy, and heavenly spirit and a great zeal for the Lord God.

4. Explanation for the Disturbance, v. 17-31

In these passages, Daniel informs King Belshazzar that he should have learned something from his grandfather King Nebuchadnezzar. Daniel told the king that the Lord placed his grandfather to rule over the land but he became haughty and filled with pride. Daniel told the king that he knew how the Lord God chose to punish his grandfather and this should have been enough to keep him safe from the same snare. The words "Mene, mene" was a first part of the writing that meant that King Belshazzar's days are numbered and finished. Daniel wanted King Belshazzar to know that his time is up. His kingdom is finished. Death is near him. The Lord God can take down one kingdom and put up another one in its place. The second part of the writing reveals the words, "Tekel" which means thou art weighed. It is King Belshazzar's actions that are now about to be weighed in the balances of divine equity. One day, we will have to stand before the judgment seat of Christ. What will you tell the righteous day? The last part of the writing on the wall includes the words, "Upharsin" which means that there will be a dividing of the kingdom. Daniel wanted King Belshazzar to know that his kingdom is divided into the hands of the Medes and the Persians. If one does not accept Jesus as their personal Savior then they will encounter "Mene, mene, tek, upharsin." This means that they will suffer the penalty of death, the judgment, and hell. We must live in a way so that men and women might come to the knowledge of the true and living God. We should try to bring someone else to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ!

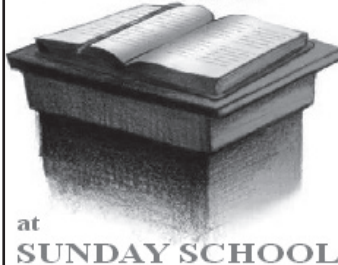

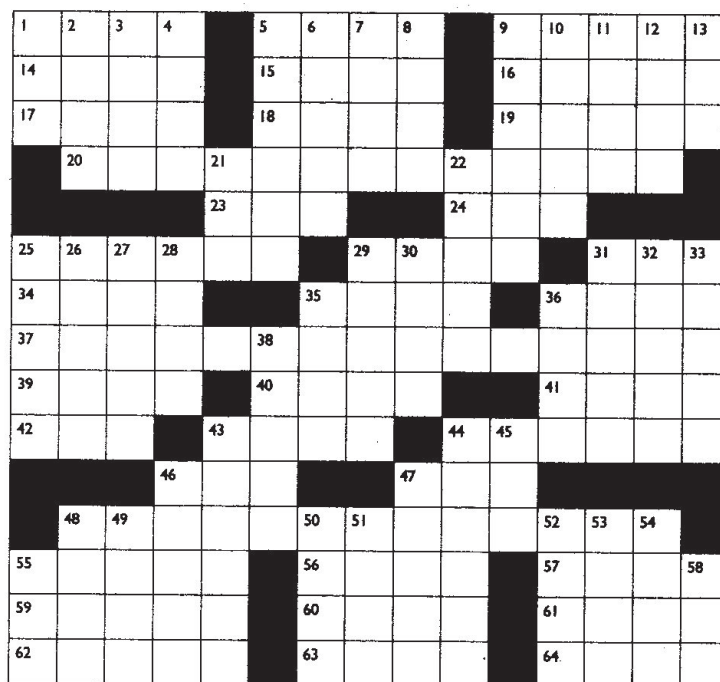

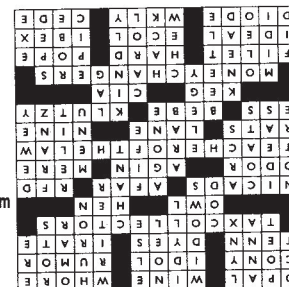
