



"The LEADER'S EDGE" by drmichaelbell

Whether we're ready for it or not, the future is here. Technology is reshaping how we live, work, and even worship. While some hesitate to welcome it into the church, we can't ignore the opportunities it brings. Artificial Intelligence (AI) isn't just for tech companies or science fiction; it's quickly becoming a practical tool for everyday congregations, especially those with limited staff and resources.

The church cannot remain on the sidelines. In average-sized congregations, where lay leaders often shoulder great responsibility, AI can help us serve more effectively. Though it may sound intimidating or impersonal, AI is simply a tool. Used wisely, it enables leaders to focus on people and mission instead of being buried in administrative details.

First, AI can sharpen communication. Every ministry thrives or falters on its ability to connect with people. Men's and women's ministries often struggle to keep members informed about studies or fellowship events. Youth and young adult ministries compete for attention in a digital world saturated with distractions. Marriage ministry leaders work to keep couples engaged between retreats or workshops.

Al tools can step in here, providing clear, creative, and consistent communication. With a few prompts, leaders can generate engaging emails, eye-catching posts, or event reminders tailored to their members. Instead of scrambling to write announcements or design graphics, leaders can begin with Al-generated drafts and then personalize them. This shift frees time for relationships and discipleship while ensuring members stay connected and informed.

Second, AI can simplify planning. Organizing ministry events often overwhelms volunteers. Whether it's a men's breakfast, a women's retreat, a youth lock-in, or a couples' date night, the details can pile up quickly. AI can help by producing checklists, timelines, and sample schedules. It can suggest themes, icebreakers, or activities tailored to the audience. By easing the planning burden, AI allows leaders to spend more energy on




community building instead of logistics.


One more thing, every vibrant ministry depends on behind-thescenes administration - tracking attendance, managing sign-ups, creating rosters, and following up with participants. Lay leaders often find these draining, especially while balancing jobs and families. Al-enabled tools can take on much of this. They generate reports to show trends, such as which events attract the most attendees. They can organize volunteer schedules without endless email threads and even assist with follow-up, helping leaders send notes of thanks or encouragement after events. This support prevents people from slipping through the cracks and strengthens ministry impact.

Of course, Al comes with cautions. Overreliance is a danger: no tool can replace prayer, discernment, or authentic human care. Technology must never substitute for the Spirit's leading. Accuracy and bias are also concerns. Al sometimes gets it wrong, so its content should always be reviewed carefully. Still, when used thoughtfully, Al can give lay leaders in average-sized churches the gift of time and creativity.

"A Life of Keys"

"25 God has given me the responsibility of serving His church by proclaiming his entire message to you. 26 This message was kept secret for centuries and generations past, but now it has been revealed to God's people. 27 For God wanted them to know that the riches and glory of Christ are for you Gentiles, too. And this is the secret: Christ lives in you. This gives you assurance of sharing his glory." (Colossians 1:25-27)

The Apostle Paul understood the concept of the keys of the Kingdom of heaven when Holy Spirit opened up the door for him to share the Good News to the Gentiles that was hidden for years, and which Jesus declared in John 10:16, "And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear my voice; and there shall be one fold, and one shepherd."

Now that the Kingdom of Heaven has been opened to us as Gentile believers, the Father has also graciously given us keys to use that represent the Kingdom of Heaven. Keys represent authority. We have been given the authority to go, share, baptize, and teach the Good News (Matthew 28:19-20). This is the basis of the key of the Kingdom of Heaven—the Gospel. But it does not stop right there. If we are to work out our salvation daily with fear and trembling (Philippians 2:12), we must take advantage of the opportunity of the keys given to us that benefit living a life of salvation.

There are so many keys available in the Kingdom of Heaven. You simply have to discover what they are, and they are found in the Father's Holy Word. As you continue to meditate upon the Word of God and ask the Holy Spirit to illuminate you to the revelation of the Father's secrets, you will gain a greater understanding of these keys' function and how to use them. These keys are powerful. Proverbs 4:7 says, "Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: And with all thy getting get understanding."

These keys include seeking His Kingdom (Matthew 6:33), living for His Kingdom (Galatians 2:20), speaking Kingdom language (1 Corinthians 2:4-5), pursuing the righteousness of the



Kingdom (Romans 4:17), living holy for the Kingdom (1 Peter 5:15-16), speaking the Kingdom doctrine (Matthew 4:4), pray according to the Kingdom (1 John 5:14), give praise for His Kingdom (Psalm 103:1), worship the Father in His Kingdom (John 4:23-24), and most of all embrace the master key of the Kingdom—love (Matthew 22:36-40).

So dear hearts, take the time to learn the power of the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven and be determined to live a life using the Kingdom keys entrusted to you.

Love Sanctuary Church of God In Christ family will celebrate the inaugural anniversary for Pastor Damarion J. Lewis and First Lady Evangelist Crystal Lewis



In October, the Love Sanctuary Church of God In Christ family will celebrate the inaugural anniversary for Pastor Damarion J. Lewis and First Lady Evangelist Crystal Lewis. Pastor and First Lady Lewis will take their place in a long legacy of faithful, resilient, and blessed lead-

Love Sanctuary Church of God in Christ had its humble beginning in 1947 in a building along Fort Worth's Vickery Blvd. as the vision of the late Supt. Augustus "Gus" Battles. Supt. Battles joined Love Chapel C.O.G.I.C., where he served as assistant pastor for more than seven years. Thereafter, Supt. Battles began his own church, which he named Love Sanctuary Church of God in Christ.

Following his death in 1965, Bishop Fred Haynes appointed Supt. Battles' son, Dr. Edward Lee Battles, pastor of Love Sanctuary. In April 1967, Dr. Battles moved Love Sanctuary to its current location at 1712 Evans Avenue in Fort Worth, which became famous for its walls adorned with no-longer-needed walking canes and the church's declaration of faith, "I Believe God."

pointed Supt. R. L. Williams to pas-

tor Love Sanctuary. Supt. Williams faithfully served as the inaugural Prelate of the Texas Metropolitan Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction (TMJ) until his death in February 2024.

In 2024, TMJ Interim Bishop Prince E. W. Bryant appointed Elder Damarion J. Lewis as the fifth pastor of Love Sanctuary. Pastor Lewis, born in Dallas, is the eldest son of Supt. Dexter and Missionary Linda Lewis. He is married to Evangelist Crystal Lewis and proud parents of three daughters: Alexandria, Kaylvn, and Hailey. Pastor Lewis began serving at Lighthouse COGIC under the late Superintendent Edward Calloway and later as Executive Pastor of Agape Temple of Deliverance alongside his father. "My first year as Pastor was incredible," Pastor Lewis said. "We are growing spiritually, numerically, and families are being restored. Passion in the church has been rekindled, and the church is on fire "

When he received his pastoral assignment, Pastor Lewis "prayed and asked God what should I focus on? Building a strong spiritual and physical organizational foundation? Healing from grief, past hurts, disappointments, relationships? Transformation of healing? Establishing an actual love connection between the Shepherd and the sheep?'

"The Word of God is delivered with clarity and insight, providing direction and purpose for every individual who hears it. By God's grace, our church is experiencing rapid growth as we joyfully welcome new families into our fellowship. We proudly uphold our declaration of faith: "I Believe God."
