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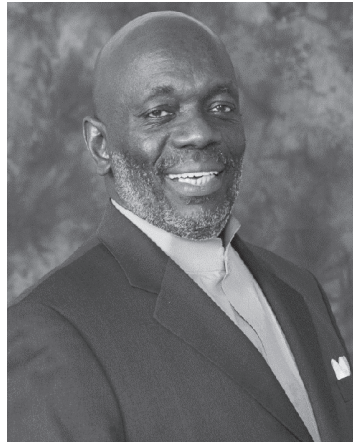
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"The LEADER'S EDGE" by drmichaelbell

Leadership in the church is a sacred and meaningful calling, but let's tell the truth about it: it can also be overwhelming. To care for people week after week, to carry their grief, absorb their anxieties, respond to their crises, and still be expected to plan, organize, evaluate, smile, and show up can wear a leader down. Many church leaders look strong in public while feeling depleted in private. And when that depletion goes unattended, it can turn into exhaustion, discouragement, irritability, isolation, and burnout. That's why tending to your mental health isn't selfish. It's stewardship. If you're going to keep pouring out, you've got to pay attention to what's going on within. Here are three habits that can help leaders maintain their well-being: Reflection, Direction, and Connection.



not? What needs my energy, and what is draining it unnecessarily? Direction creates boundaries, and boundaries aren't barriers to ministry; they're protections for ministry. When you have direction, you don't live at the mercy of every demand. You lead with intention, and intention is good for the mind.

First, **reflection**. Every leader needs time to regularly look back, look at now, and look ahead. Reflection gives you space to ask honest questions: How has this season affected me? Where am I mentally and emotionally right now? Too many leaders keep moving without ever checking in with themselves. But if you never slow down, you can't tell whether you're leading from clarity or merely reacting from fatigue.

Reflection sharpens your tools because it sharpens your awareness. It helps you notice when your patience is short, your spirit is tired, or your joy is dissipating. It gives you room to pray, journal, think, breathe, and tell yourself the truth. A reflective leader is not a weak leader. A reflective leader is a wiser leader.

Second, **direction**. It's not enough to ask how you feel; you also need to ask where you're going and how you're growing. Direction helps you take stock of your path. It reminds you that busyness is not the same thing as purpose, and activity is not the same thing as effectiveness.

Sometimes leaders become mentally drained because they've been saying yes to everything and no to nothing. Direction helps you realign. It lets you ask: What is mine to do in this season, and what is

Then there's **connection**. Leaders never go it alone. Leaders need people. Period. We need relationships that are honest, life-giving, and safe. We need people who know us beyond our title, people who can check on us, challenge us, encourage us, and remind us that we are human beings, not just helping machines. That's why every leader ought to cultivate an Inner Circle and build an Outer Circle. Your Inner Circle is made up of trusted people who can handle your truth. Your Outer Circle includes mentors, colleagues, and companions who strengthen your journey. And let's be clear: there is nothing wrong with having a trusted therapist or counselor in either group. Sometimes healing requires conversation and professional support. Leader, don't go it alone. Reflection helps you know yourself. Direction helps you order your life. Connection helps you sustain your life. And when those three habits work together, you don't just survive leadership; you lead well and stay well.

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Speak Life Thought with Dr. Yolanda G. Butler

"A Life Protected & Guided"

"Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; Thy rod and thy staff they comfort me." (Psalm 23:4)

Psalm 23 is probably one of the most quoted psalms in the Book of Psalms. It is a beautiful expression of David's heart as a shepherd and serves as an encouragement to pastoral service. It also serves as a promise of protection and guidance to the Father's children. It describes God's providential care in providing refreshment, guidance, protection, and abundance, and so affording grounds of confidence in His perpetual favor towards us.

The "valley of the shadow of death" is a deep ravine overhung with cliffs, filled with dense forests that cast shadows, giving the impression of a predator. To the sheep, this would incite fear and confusion, prompting them to avert the perceived danger, but with the shepherd's staff of guidance, they would be safely led through the valley to safe territory.

There are dark seasons that may arise in our lives. Death, loss, tragedy, trauma, sickness, and other dark areas can spiral us down the road of distress. Fear is the common emotion fueled by such incidents as these. We have a sure promise that through every dark valley in your life the Father is there to pull you straight through to the other side.

We learn several valuable principles from this one verse.

1) Acknowledgement. The Psalmist acknowledged his dark season. Acknowledging your dark season is the first step toward healing and deliverance.

2) Faith. After acknowledging the deep darkness, the Psalmist began to speak faith to himself and the situation by declaring, "I will fear no evil." This implies that while the shadows of the enemy's tactics may be present, you do not have to surrender to his tactics. Rather, cast your total faith and reliance in the One who made a promise to never leave you or forsake you (Deut. 31:8, Hebrews 13:5).

3) Protection and Guidance. The shepherd carries two important tools with him at all times—rod and staff. The rod, a type of club, was used to protect the sheep from predators and count individual sheep. This represents the Father's promise to protect against outside intruders while correcting when attempting to stray away. The staff, a long stick with a distinct crook, was used to provide gentle guidance and care. This is the Father's promise to provide intimate care and guidance along the right path of righteousness and holiness.

4) Comfort. This word here means to relieve distress and sorrow, providing consolation and encouragement. This is the Father's promise of providing legal encouragement to believers. Jesus told the disciples it was necessary He leave, but not without the Father sending the Comforter, the Holy Spirit



(John 14: 16, 26). The Comforter would come alongside the Father's children to bring truth and assured presence, promise, saving work, and ministry of the Holy Spirit. Therefore, when you pray for comfort to be released, you are praying that the Father manifests His presence, promises, and power.

Finally, while the enemy tries to cast is ugly shadow to bully and intimidate the saints in fear, the Father's shadow brings far greater power than the enemy. Believers can safely dwell in the secret place of the very shadow of the Almighty that yields protection, healing, and comfort (Psalm 91:1, 17:8, 121:5).

So dear hearts, be determined to walk through every valley knowing that Holy Spirit is there to pull you through to the other side of victory in Jesus Christ.

A PASTOR WITH A HEART FOR 76104

Pastor Kyev P. Tatum, Sr. |

Forty Years of Civil Rights. Nearly Thirty Years of Gospel Ministry. A Lifetime Fighting for Life.

For Pastor Kyev P. Tatum, Sr., Fort Worth's 76104 is more than a ZIP code. It is personal.

Born at Peter Smith Hospital, reared in the Hillside community of Morningside, and a graduate of Green B. Trimble Technical High School—all in 76104—Pastor Tatum has come full circle to serve as Pastor of New Mount Rose Missionary Baptist Church in the community that raised him.

Born here. Reared here. Educated here. Now serving here.

A graduate of the University of North Texas, Tatum spent sixteen years, from 1988 to 2004, as a university administrator at UNT, Texas Woman's University, and Texas State University. His career in higher education helped shape his lifelong commitment to education, youth development, leadership, and opportunity.

But his commitment to 76104 goes much deeper. Pastor Tatum has lost eight of eleven family members, including his beloved mother, Carol Tatum—all before reaching age 65.

For him, premature death and disparities in life expectancy are not statistics. They have names. They have faces. They are his family.

Those losses have fueled a per-

sonal mission to improve life expectancy and quality of life in 76104 and beyond. He believes where people live should never determine how long they have the opportunity to live.

Tatum began his civil rights journey in 1986 and has spent forty years working at the intersection of faith, justice, and community development. His work has addressed education, hunger, health disparities, economic opportunity, youth development, violence prevention, and neighborhood revitalization. His philosophy is simple: civil rights is not only about protesting what is wrong—it is about building what is right.

In October 1997, while attending the Texas NAACP Convention, Tatum accepted his call to preach as Bishop John Richard Bryant preached from Nehemiah 4 the message "Fight By Family." He later joined Grant AME Church and helped develop the John Richard Bryant Training and Development Center in Austin.

Today, as Pastor of New Mount Rose Missionary Baptist Church and President of the Ministers

Justice Coalition of Texas, Tatum continues connecting faith with action. During the COVID-19 pandemic, he helped lead a church-based distribution hub that moved more than \$25 million in donated goods and resources, serving hundreds of church-

es and community organizations across the country.

His ministry now extends beyond the pulpit into food access, health, education, agriculture, economic empowerment, emergency response, violence prevention, and neighborhood revitalization—all connected to one mission: helping people live longer, healthier, and better lives.

Pastor Tatum is married to Sister Tonya Tatum, and together their family includes seven children and fifteen grandchildren. He is fighting because of the generations he has lost, for the generations still here, and for those yet to come.

Born in 76104. Reared in 76104. Educated in 76104. Pastoring in 76104. Fighting for longer life in 76104—and beyond.

For Pastor Tatum, coming home was never the end of the journey. It was the beginning of the assignment.

It's more than ministry. It's more than civil rights. It's personal.

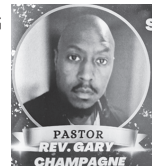

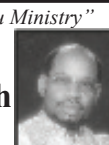

Fort Worth Frenchtown - A Black Community Lost in History



Frenchtown got its name from the Creole and French-speaking Louisiana families who settled there, building one of Fort Worth's most tight-knit African American communities from the ground up.

The neighborhood developed in the early 1900s just south of downtown Fort Worth, growing into a self-sufficient community with its own churches, schools, and small businesses at a time when Black

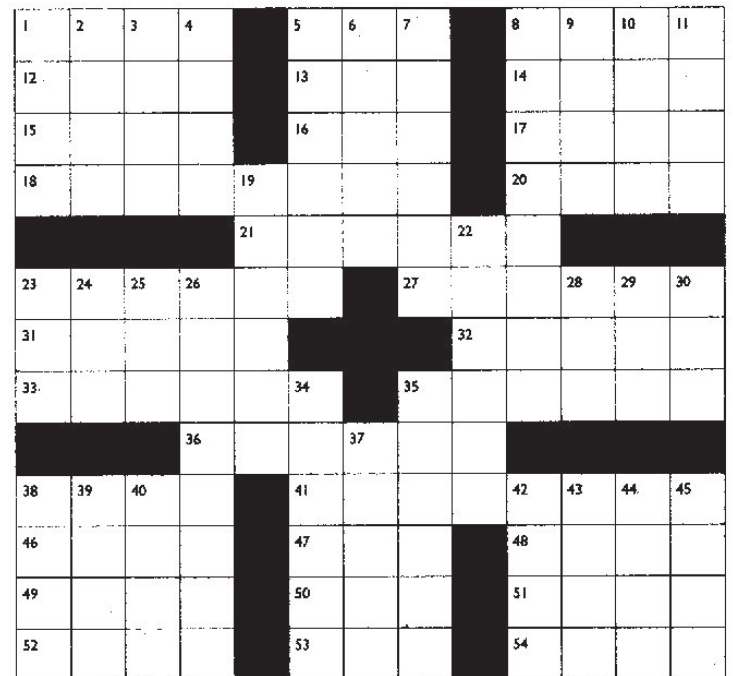
residents faced significant restrictions on where they could live and shop elsewhere in the city. Despite operating under segregation, Frenchtown residents built a genuine community identity, with many families tracing their roots back to Louisiana Creole culture, distinct cuisine, and Catholic traditions that set the neighborhood apart from other historically Black areas of Fort Worth.

Like a lot of historically Black neighborhoods across Texas cities, Frenchtown shrank significantly over the decades due to highway construction and urban renewal projects that cut through or displaced parts of the community starting in the mid-twentieth century.

Had you heard of Frenchtown before, or is this the first time learning about this corner of Fort Worth's history?

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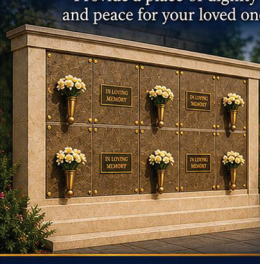
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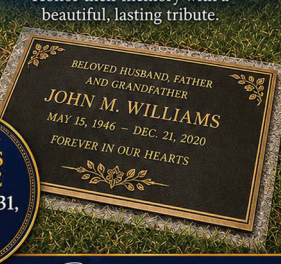


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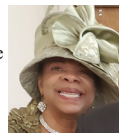
